Kindly note, this new feature is a condensed version of my typical full card precise order handicap & measured win probability percentage. The same full handicapping approach has been applied, and for your convenience, I am providing an extended precise order in some races based on the field size, so you have handicapped options for your engagement in wagering on deeper exotics like triples and superfectas. As always, my precise final order is based on my findings for overall win probability. Let's go-get-em

Race #1

#7 Nerazurri. A sharp looking filly comes up from Florida, I like her stretching out and feel she has raced with better/faster fillies, and now a major upgrade to Irad Ortiz as the pilot, I'm confident she will get an adventurous trip and have the most left coming down the lane. She has raced with inflated odds, much shorter price today. #4 Indy Label fits well here too. 7-4-6-1-2 is full order for exotics.

Race # 2

#1 Zuccherro. This is a Mendelssohn colt making his 2nd start & dropping for a tag after an extremely challenging debut at Kentucky Downs on the turf while breaking from the extreme outside. I trust the barn and Luis Saez is new, and this isn't a real tough field of maidens. #5 Awesome Magic should improve as well, dangerous with best effort. Full for exotics 1-5-8-9-6-12

Race #3

#6 Sneakily. An attractive and expensive daughter of Tapit had an unfortunate trip in her debut on the lawn at Ellis Park on August 18th, her works since aren't too fast, but considering how she finished into a .25 and .50 pace, she showed willingness to compete, and I feel the stretch out will help her too. #1 Turner's Charm stretches out as well with Frankie Dettori up for Brandon Walsh, should sit a nice trip too, top contender making 2nd start on lawn and has been working exclusively on the synthetic. I like this 6-4 DD play. & Feeling the P3: 6,1/4,1/6,5

Race #4

#4 Spa Prospector. Developing filly, daughter of Authentic, makes her 1st start since August 3rd where she was ambitiously entered in the G3 Adirondack, ran well early with fast fractions and faltered late, I like they was she's been working and I trust the Tom Amoss barn, feeling a strong forward race here in this competitive field on paper. #1 Kingsolver gets Prat back, this filly ran a strong race despite trouble at Saratoga defeating #5 My Sweetheart, and now cuts back to that winning distance, dangerous with her best.

Race #5

#6 Divine Justice. This son of Justify was razor sharp on debut while taking in all the money at Ellis Park, now stretches out a furlong & gets Tyler Gaffalione back up for Brad Cox and he draws a more favorable post as well. I see talent in this guy, and I consider it hard to dismiss vs this group, he's not single to me, but the most likely winner. #5 Hitchcock makes his 2nd start off a long layoff, but looks sharp, fresh, fit and dangerous off his workouts, especially his most recent 5-furlong breeze in 59.2 stronger contender with his best.

Race #6

#6 In the Stars. This Into Mischief filly improved brilliantly to graduate on the lawn at Kentucky Downs, no doubt she will need a smart trip here, however from the #6 post, I feel she gets it with Luis Saez up foe Rusty Arnold. In race review, to me she won 'effortlessly' and I would be surprised if she didn't go forward again now facing winners for the 1st time. #12 Moden Sound, drew this extreme outside post, but I feel she will handle the stretch out and trust Flavian Prat in the saddle, a contender for sure, how often have we seen Mike Maker do wonders with a claim? I really like this extra & triple/super as betting opportunities.

Race #7

#5 Nakatomi. This hard-hitting gelding who is now age 6 is no doubt a 'horse for the course' running many of his better races here at Keeneland (5 for 6 in exactas) I know he's only 2 for 14 at this sprinting distance and he is facing some very consistent and reliable sprinters, but I trust his back class, and the conditioning of Wesley Ward who gets Irad back up as well. He's been on the shelf since July 19th, but I love the way he's been working, looks to be fresh, fit and very dangerous. #3 Skelly is often under-appreciated, but he possesses high speed and has finished in the exacta 18 times in 22 races at the distance, winning 12, must be respected.

Full Precise: 5-3-4-2

Race #8 (Note: If #14 Dyna somehow draws in on the turf, insert as my 2nd choice & use in your multiples as I am.

#12 Time To Dream. This filly will take solid money at the window as she should because she has looked fabulous in both her starts, the 750k daughter of Not This Time starting for Repole Staples with Irad up for Pletcher should remind you that they win races like this all the time. Sure, it's the #12 hole, but I trust Irad to keep her in quality position to make yet another big run in the stretch. #1 Lit Ship and #2 Mackinac have also been impressive fillies and I consider them contenders in this G2 Jessamine Stakes.

Full precise: 12-1-2-4-9 (14) *see above

Race #9

#3 Tommy Jo. Dynamic juvenile filly appears to have the BC, Fantasy & Kentucky Oaks name on her. Looks like Spendthrift Farms has a special filly brewing, Johnny V up for Pletcher, now she stretches out, however I have no reservations about the added distance, I know she will be a very short price, a single for me, and she turns the late P5 into a Pick 4, I simply cannot make an argument to get past her. I will however play a very strong exacta with #1 Percy's Bar (Same as the Spinaway) and #4 The Grumpy Rabbit who I feel are talented fillies who should move forward too.

Precise: 3-1-4-2

Race #10

#7 Inkling. This is a good-looking Godolphin filly, the daughter of Street Sense who I feel can easily fall under the radar in this maiden special weight field. I like her post with Vince Cheminaud up for Eoin Harty, I absolutely love her complete workout tab for this debut, a series of quality breezes on the synthetic at Turfway Park, I'm expecting her to be a runner at first asking at a potential big price. #10 Market Chill has the race experience with Prat up for Chad Brown, an obvious contender to graduate. I'm going 4-deep in my P5, and play most exotics in this race, and a robust DD with the top choice filly in the 11th.
