

1/ST RACING
~ NEW CAW RULES ~

The following new rules take effect starting on **Monday, September 26, 2022** for all Thoroughbred racetracks owned by 1/ST Racing. These tracks include Golden Gate Fields, Gulfstream Park, Laurel Park, Pimlico Racecourse, and Santa Anita Park.

NEW WIN POOL RULE

Each CAW player betting into the win pools of 1/ST Racetracks may elect to be either a Regular Bettor or an Early Bettor. Any player who fails to make a choice will be deemed to be a Regular Bettor. The election can be made on a track-by-track basis (e.g., a player may elect to be a Regular Bettor at Gulfstream Park and an Early Bettor at Santa Anita Park). The election made by a player with respect to a particular racetrack cannot be changed during that racetrack's racing season without the consent of the racetrack.

The following rules apply to the win wagers of Regular Bettors:

- The player may place wagers into the win pool at whatever time(s) prior to pool closing and in whatever amount(s) that the player chooses.
- The host fee payable by the player to the racetrack for wagers into the win pool will be increased by 3.5%, resulting in a corresponding decrease in the player's rebate of 3.5%.

The following rules apply to Early Bettors:

- The player must place at least 80% of the player's win pool wagers in one or more bet drops occurring no later than 1 minute-to-post (the "First Bet Drop"). In other words, the First Bet Drop may consist of one bet drop or multiple bet drops which in the aggregate amount to at least 80% of the player's total wagers into the win pool for that race, and must occur prior to the time the minutes-to-post countdown clicks from 2 to 1 on the Amtote data feed.
- After the First Bet Drop, the player may wager up to 20% of the player's total wagers into the win pool for that race at any time in one or more bet drops.

Example: Assume the player makes the following win wagers in the First Bet Drop: \$150 on the #3 and \$50 on the #6. Thereafter, the Early Bettor may wager an additional \$50 into the win pool in one or more additional bet drops at whatever time(s) the player chooses.

- After the First Bet Drop, any further win pool wagers placed by the player on a particular runner cannot exceed 3% of the total pool amount for that runner at pool closing.

Example: If the pool closes with \$5,000 wagered to win on the #5, the player can bet as much as he wants on the #5 in the First Bet Drop, but the player is limited to no more than \$150 in the aggregate on the #5 in any subsequent bet drop(s).

- The host fee payable by the player to the racetrack for wagers into the win pool will be decreased by 1.5%, resulting in a corresponding increase in the player's rebate of 1.5% (and creating a 5% differential between the Regular Bettors and the Early Bettors). The favorable host fee applies both to wagers in the First Bet Drop and also to wagers in any subsequent bet drop(s).

- The win wagers of each Early Bettor will be audited on a post-race basis, and failure to adhere to the Early Bettor rules will result in forfeiture of all win pool rebates for the day at the racetrack where the violation occurred. Multiple violations by a player will result in the player being disqualified as an Early Bettor at all 1/ST Racetracks.

NEW JACKPOT WAGER RULE

Any CAW player betting into a Pick 6 Jackpot pool at a 1/ST Racetrack will have to self-disqualify from the jackpot on any day that does not have a mandatory payout.

The self-disqualification must be achieved by wagering no less than two minimum increments on each combination wagered by the player. As a result, any winning combination wagered by a CAW player will not be a "single ticket" because there were two units wagered on the combination. The CAW player will still be entitled to the consolation payoff (times two) but will not win the jackpot portion of the pool.

The Pick 6 Jackpot pool wagers of CAW players will be audited on a post-race basis. Failure to adhere to the self-disqualification rule will result in forfeiture of all Pick 6 pool rebates for the day at the racetrack where the violation occurred, and will also result in the forfeiture of any jackpot that the player wins on that day.

On days with a mandatory payout of the jackpot portion of the pool, self-disqualification is not required and CAW players will be allowed to wager a single minimum increment on a combination.
