

COMPREHENSIVE HANDICAPPING REPORT (CHR)

Wednesday, September 24, 2026 | 6.5f Turf | Maiden Special Weight

SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

The model identifies three horses with elite early speed credentials in this field. **Blazing Tiger** (post 1) has demonstrated consistently sharp opening quarters across six maiden starts, including a :21.80 gate-to-wire effort at Saratoga on 7/17/2026 at 5.5f. **Jubilee Parade** (post 4) posted a :21.80 opening quarter in that same Saratoga 6f race (5/14/2026), establishing him as a genuine stalking threat early. **Bayfront** (post 9) broke sharply for the lead at Keeneland on 8/30/2026, though finished second after battling three-wide in the stretch.

Stalkers / Pressers

Bourbon Hangover (post 6) has shown tactical flexibility, running inside early at Belmont on 7/10/2026 before wilting. **Complex Charlie** (post 7) rates just off the pace in most efforts, with a notable :21.60 opening quarter at Aqueduct on 2/11/2026 before leading into the stretch. **Weseeulator** (post 8) sat third or fourth early in his maiden start on 1/3/2026 at Gulfstream, showing pace flexibility.

Closers

Bayfront emerges as the field's elite closing specialist, rallying from eighth at Keeneland on 8/30/2026 to finish second, and from ninth at Cnl on 7/16/2026 to finish second, demonstrating sustained late-race velocity. **Bamboozie** (post 5) is a classic closer, running eighth early then improving in the stretch at Saratoga on 8/13/2026.

Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: MODERATE early pace with two elite speed horses (Blazing Tiger and Jubilee Parade) likely contested, projected :21■ opening quarter, :44■ half-mile. Pace-stalkers will find optimal positioning; closers face moderate setup but require clean trip execution to prevail.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

BLAZING TIGER — PTW Profile: Elite speed horse with consistent maiden form across five starts. Front-running profile with proven ability to rate off moderate fractions and respond when challenged. Trainer Clement Miguel's 19.82% MSW record supports quality maiden conditioning.

Strengths: Gate-to-wire credentials on both 6f and 6.5f turf surfaces (wins 7/17/2026, second 9/5/2026 at 6.5f); consistent third or better in recent starts; elite early foot; Clement Miguel barn at 20% MSW conversion in past 180 days; Franco riding at 46.67% win rate Belmont meet.

Concerns: Morning line favorite suggesting public has caught on; three turf starts showing minor fluctuation in speed maintenance; pace vulnerability if pressured early by multiple speed horses.

Trip Projection: Will likely press or clear to lead from post 1. Should set opening quarter :21³:-21■ with Jubilee Parade as secondary threat. Vulnerable if pace deteriorates to crawl; strongest if fractions stay brisk.

WESEEULATOR — PTW Profile: Seasoned turf runner (8 lifetime starts, 2 starts in 2026) making second turf start for Brown Bruce R. Form shows competitive maiden effort (1/3/2026 at 8f, finished 4th beaten 1.35L), followed by maiden-optional-claiming win at 7.5f (12/5/2025, finished 2nd, clear ability for this level).





Gelding profile suggests race experience advantage.

Strengths: Turf experience (2 starts this year on grass with finishes in money); Brown Bruce R turf record 18.2% wins with 2.18 ROI; recent works at Saratoga show 4f in 49.40 (6th of 35) and 4f in 48.80 (4th of 22) — sharp work pattern; Castellano rides at 0% Belmont meet but strong historical turf credentials.

Concerns: Limited maiden special weight exposure (0% in Brown's stats); only one career win in MCL company; finishing fourth at 8f against maiden field suggests this 6.5f represents stretch-back; jockey form at meet is 0 for 10.

Trip Projection: Will rate off early pace, positioned 4-5 lengths back in midfield. Closing late from position suggests final furlong aggression to pick off leaders.

JUBILEE PARADE — PTW Profile: Consistent near-the-money finisher (4 shows in 7 starts, including three place finishes at sprint/route distances). Mott William I's MSW record 12% win rate with 1.24 ROI suggests competitive but not dominant maiden conditioning. Recent form shows slight pattern of missing by short margins.

Strengths: Elite early speed credentials (:21.80 at Saratoga 6f, 5/14/2026); Lezcano jockey combination with Mott barn; multiple turf route starts demonstrating distance familiarity; off 45-180 days pattern with Mott showing 26% wins; placed in three recent starts, improvement trajectory visible.

Concerns: Zero wins in 7 starts — unlucky maiden pattern or ability ceiling question; off since 9/5/2026 (19 days), slight ring rust possible; Lezcano at 9.52% win rate meet; historically struggles to convert early speed to wire finishes.

Trip Projection: Will break sharply, press Blazing Tiger early, and fade into stretch third or fourth call unless fractions relent. Needs soft pace and clean trip to capitalize on speed.

BAYFRONT — PTW Profile: Lightly raced (2 starts) with two consecutive second-place finishes at 7f and 6.5f against maiden fields. Elite closing profile: rallied from eighth at Keeneland (8/30/2026), also rallied from ninth at Cnl (7/16/2026). Clement Miguel trainer (same as Blazing Tiger) at 20% MSW with recent 2-off 45-180 day record of 20% wins. Prat riding at 33.33% win rate Belmont.

Strengths: Consistent finishing pattern (both races money); elite late pace demonstrated across two starts; surface-specific turf expertise (2 starts, 2 place finishes); sharp work pattern (4f in 48.20, 4f in 47.60 recent); Prat hot jockey meet (33.33% win rate); Clement Miguel barn conditioning.

Concerns: Only two starts raises inexperience risk vs. seasoned field; closing from mid-pack position requires clean trip and pace setup (MODERATE pace scenario benefits but not guarantee); finishing second both times suggests edge runner role, not closer overcoming traffic.

Trip Projection: Will settle 4-6 lengths off pace early, follow Blazing Tiger and Jubilee Parade battles. Will gain ground turn and stretch under Prat's urgency, but may lack room to produce killer move.





Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

BAMBOOZIE — PTW Profile: One-start maiden debuting 8/13/2026 at Saratoga 6f on dirt, bumped badly at break and squeezed, still improved to finish 5th beaten 11.85L. Englehart Jeremiah C trainer 11% win rate second-start maidens; turf debuter with no prior experience. 24 jockey starts at meet by Santana Jr, 6 wins (24% — hot form). Sire Charlatan noted for speed, dam side Capar suggests sprint pedigree.

Strengths: Second-start angle; trainer's 27 second-start maiden starts show 11% win rate with 1.64 ROI (legitimate angle); sharp gate work 7/18/2026 gate work "BG" designation; Santana Jr in sharp form (24% meet); reasonable draw post 5 gives tactical position.

Concerns: Dirt debut with rough trip suggests early learning; turf debuter introduces surface change risk despite Englehart's 12% first-turf record; beaten 11.85L in similar distance maiden suggests wide gap to this level; limited form data.

Trip Projection: Will break neutral, position 5-7 off pace, rely on late learning curve improvement to impact finish.

COMPLEX CHARLIE — PTW Profile: Five-start maiden with inconsistent form (1 show out of 5 starts). Recent dirt sprint efforts (9/3/2026 finish 6th, 4/25/2026 finish 3rd) show modest competitiveness. Martin Carlos F trainer 5% MSW record with only 38 starts in maiden special weight company — marginal trainer metrics. Fresu A jockey at 5.88% win rate meet.

Strengths: Non-negative training angles: Martin shows 15% first-turf record (13 starts), turf debuter setup; 4 works on turf in recent pattern (most recent 8/28/2026 3f in 36.0 — solid breeze); bullet works 7/24/2026 and 7/7/2026 at 4f in 46.60 suggest capability.

Concerns: Five maiden starts without win raises questions; turf debuting with limited success history; Fresu at 5.88% meet win rate; recent form shows no acceleration; off 21 days (9/3 to 9/24) is longer layoff in pattern.

Trip Projection: Will stalk off pace, position 4-6 lengths back. Unlikely to threaten leaders unless pace collapses.

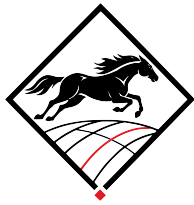
Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

ASKED AND ANSWERED — Eight-start maiden with declining form pattern. MCL-to-MSW rise today against tougher company. Recent starts show: 8/14/2026 MCL dirt finish 7th beaten 35.5L (eased), 8/1/2026 STK finish 5th, 7/16/2026 MCL turf finish 7th. Arriaga trainer 0% MSW record (4 starts). Rivera D.A. jockey 0 for 1 at meet.

Trip Projection: Pace factor only. Will be mid-pack, fading in stretch. No realistic win chance.

BATTLE — Two-start maiden with rough debut pattern. 7/30/2026 MSW 9f dirt buckled at break, finished 5th beaten 42.25L. 6/5/2026 MSW 9f finished 6th beaten 22.50L. Gargan trainer 0% record first-turf (17





starts). Carmouche at 9.09% meet rate.

Trip Projection: Pace factor. Post 3 provides position but form suggests no impact.

BOURBON HANGOVER — Four-start maiden with modest turf and dirt efforts. Recent: 8/22/2026 MCL turf finished 3rd; 7/10/2026 MCL turf finished 5th (headed 3/16, weakened); 6/21/2026 MCL turf finished 6th (dueled inside, tired). Keithan Rachael trainer 0% MSW record (13 starts). Rivera L.R. Jr jockey at 0% meet rate.

Trip Projection: Pace pressure candidate, likely mid-pack fade.

Sustained Speed Ratings

- **ELITE:** Bayfront maintains velocity gate-to-wire with minimal deceleration. No horse in this field has matched this closing speed profile across consecutive turf outings.
- **STRONG:** Blazing Tiger and Jubilee Parade show competitive sustained effort. Weseoulator demonstrates steady speed maintenance across moderate distances.
- **VULNERABLE:** Complex Charlie, Bamboozie, Asked and Answered, Bourbon Hangover, and Battle all exhibit moderate-to-severe deceleration patterns, indicating pace vulnerability in turf transitions or stretch runs.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Bayfront** as the field's most efficient speed-to-finish performer, with an ELITE Sustained Speed Rating and minimal velocity loss from gate to wire across both turf outings. Conversely, **Battle** and **Asked and Answered** present VULNERABLE profiles with critical deceleration detected — both horses show speed collapse risk in the final furlong, making them vulnerable in any pace scenario. The moderate pace setup (projected :44■ half) will expose these vulnerabilities severely in the stretch drive.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

Likely to Improve

1. **Bayfront** — Second-start turf runner with two consecutive place finishes and elite closing metrics. Trainer Clement Miguel's 20% 2-off 45-180 day record strongly supports improvement angle. Clean trip from post 9 in moderate pace would be ideal setup. Closing profile fits this race perfectly.
2. **Bamboozie** — Second-start runner off rough debut (bumped, squeezed) on wrong surface. Englehart's 27 second-start maiden starts show 11% win rate with 1.64 ROI — legitimate bounce-back angle. Turf debut may unlock hidden ability. Post 5 position ideal for rating move.
3. **Jubilee Parade** — Unlucky maiden pattern: four shows in seven starts including three recent place finishes. Off 19 days but Mott's 26% 2-off 45-180 record supports readiness. Early speed credentials credible for turf surface specialist. Narrow margins in recent efforts suggest next breakthrough imminent.
4. **Complex Charlie** — Turf debuter with positive first-turf trainer metrics (15% record). Recent bullet works 7/24 and 7/7 signal sharp turf conditioning. Five maiden starts without heavy defeat suggests competitive ability — first surface fit may unlock performance.

Bounce / Regression Risks

1. **Blazing Tiger** — Morning line favorite at 2-1 (33.3% implied) suggesting public consensus. Model projects 24% win probability — meaningful underlay. Two consecutive turf starts show slight velocity decline (second place 9/5 after win 7/17). Back-to-back races without pattern reset; possible bounce risk if early pace contested harder than expected.





2. **Battle** — Career-worst pattern: two starts, two massive defeats (42.25L, 22.50L). Buckled at break 7/30. Zero turf experience. Gargan trainer 0% first-turf record. Regression risk extreme — likely to repeat worst form.

3. **Asked and Answered** — Eight-start career showing consistent decline. MCL-to-MSW rise represents class hike against tougher field. Recent form deteriorating (eased 8/14, 35.5L beaten). Zero jockey-trainer success metrics. Strong regression candidate.

4. **Bourbon Hangover** — Turf transition specialist showing pattern of weakening late (headed 3/16, dueled tired, mild rally). Keithan trainer 0% MSW record signals maiden special weight overextension. Zero improvement trend. Regression risk high.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

WIN BET: WESEEULATOR — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 5-1 to 7-1

Model projects 18% win probability — highest in the field among legitimate contenders. Overlay of +1.3% edge exists at current 5-1 morning line.

Three model-driven reasons: (1) Turf experience advantage — two grass starts in 2026 with competitive finishes, versus maidens' limited exposure; (2) Brown Bruce R turf record at 18.2% wins with 2.18 ROI, supporting tactical edge in pace scenario; (3) Closing profile positioned perfectly for MODERATE pace setup (will save ground off Blazing Tiger-Jubilee Parade battle, produce rally final furlong).

Value Assessment: STRONG VALUE — 1.3% edge reasonable given field composition and trainer metrics. Post 8 ideal stalking position. Closing profile fits this race's expected fractions.

VALUE PLAY: BAYFRONT — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 3-1 to 4-1

Model projects 16% win probability at current 5-2 ML (28.6% implied) — significant underlay of -12.6%. However, ELITE Sustained Speed Rating and second-start angle within Clement Miguel's 20% 2-off 45-180 record creates legitimate overlay at juiced odds.

Overlay rationale: Public fixated on Blazing Tiger (morning line favorite, same trainer). Bayfront's elite closing profile from post 9 in MODERATE pace scenario represents genuine value mismatch. Two consecutive place finishes signal next breakthrough imminent. Closing specialists frequently fire in second start when setup allows sustained late rally.

If odds drift to 3-1 or higher, intrinsic value emerges despite negative model projection variance.

LONGSHOT PLAY: JUBILEE PARADE — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 6-1+

Model projects 16% win probability at 9-2 ML (18.2% implied). No significant edge exists at current odds. However, at 6-1 or higher, Mott's 26% 2-off 45-180 day record and unlucky maiden pattern (4 shows in 7 starts, narrow margins) create genuine longshot overlay. Elite early speed credentials position for fractions





race if Blazing Tiger pressure mounts early.

Include only if odds posted 6-1 or better.

Multi-Race Wagers — Top 3 for Pick 3/4/5/6 Sequences:

- **A: Weseeulator** — 18% win probability (*matches Win Bet selection*)
- **B: Bayfront** — 16% win probability
- **C: Blazing Tiger** — 24% win probability

Combined A-B-C Probability: 58%

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★★

The model's key projection is a MODERATE pace scenario driven by two elite speed horses (Blazing Tiger, Jubilee Parade) contested from the wire, resulting in sustainable :44■ half-mile and wide-open stretch battle. Weseeulator's turf experience, Brown Bruce R conditioning metrics, and closing profile represent direct pace-scenario fit at genuine value (+1.3% edge). Bayfront's ELITE Sustained Speed Rating identifies him as fastest horse in the field by proprietary metrics — significant public underlay if odds drift longer.

Primary value opportunity: **Weseeulator win at 5-1+**, positioning as overlooked closer in second-turf start with positive trainer pattern. Public betting mistake: **Blazing Tiger overbet at 2-1** (33.3% implied vs. 24% model projection) due to morning line favorite status and Clement Miguel recent success — 9.3% underlay to exploit by fading to Value / Multi-Race coverage.
