

COMPREHENSIVE HANDICAPPING REPORT (CHR)

SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

Private Property blazed a front-running profile last out on 9/22 (MCL), position 1 at Call 1, position 5 at 3/8ths, rallying to dominant victory by 0.05 lengths. The model identifies elite early acceleration paired with tactical flexibility — drawn post 14 today provides running room to rate. Island Charm displayed 4-wide pursuit tactics on 8/13 (STR), then demonstrated front-running form 7/16 (MCL 8.5f turf), leading into the stretch before capitulating late — suggests speed dependency in modest pace scenarios. Roseberns Dream won decisively 6/25 (MCL 8.5f turf), in-hand two-path early before asking and drawing away — profile indicates sustained early control under tactical confidence.

Stalkers / Pressers

Spinning Class earns consistent 3-4 path pursuit positioning, 2p turn and 4-wide upper positioning on 6/27 (MCL 8.5f turf) before rallying for victory. Putonahappyface rates inside with tactical awareness, 2-4p positioning patterns across multiple MCL/AOC starts on turf. Luckforyou demonstrated in-hand 2p positioning on 5/3/26 (CLM 8.5f turf), rallying from inside ground — profile suggests pace-stalker flexibility.

Closers

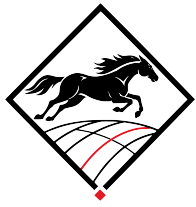
Hola Gata's veteran turf profile shows consistent back-in-pack positioning with powerful closing rallies — 2/24 (AOC turf) surged from 11p to 2p finish, outfinishing rest of field. Juliet On Approach displayed winning form from outside in the slop 4/23 (MSW turf), besting rest after early angle work — profile indicates late-run capability from ground-saving setup.

Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: MODERATE pace scenario — projected :24² opening quarter, :49¹ half-mile. Private Property's front-running intent will establish clear tempo. Island Charm and Roseberns Dream provide secondary speed threats, but no suicidal pace duel projected. Moderate tempo setup favors pace-stalkers and positioned closers over pure speed horses.

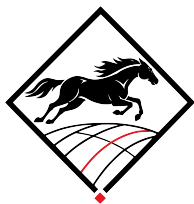

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

TIER 1 — PRIMARY CONTENDERS ★★★★★

PRIVATE PROPERTY (Post 14)





PTW Profile: The model identifies Private Property as the field's most dangerous wire-to-wire threat. Recent victory (9/22, MCL 8.5f turf) shows dominant front-running form, in-hand control into stretch, decisive finishing kick (0.05 length margin). Enters claiming field following MCL victory with live barn move — trainer Michelle Nevin shows 21% ROI on routes, 14% on turf claiming (67% hit rate for 31-60 day patterns). Post 14 draws awkwardly but tactical speed gives control of race flow.

Strengths: Career 8-1-3-0 at turf route distance; consistent front-running profile; proven MCL form; recent MCL win strength indicator; trainer pattern ROI; jockey Carmouche at 9% meet win rate shows steady form.

Concerns: Claiming drop may trigger claiming move today — public likely to overbet recent winner stepping down in company. Post 14 requires aggressive outside journey. One layoff concern, though workout pattern (50.2, 50.8 on 9/6-9/14) shows sufficient fitness.

Trip Projection: Break sharp from post 14, settle 3-4 wide, control tempo through :49¹ half. Set up stretch drive as clear front-runner in moderate pace scenario. Vulnerable only to elite closers with perfect trip.

SPINNING CLASS (Post 9)

PTW Profile: The model projects Spinning Class as the field's strongest closer and primary overlay candidate. Route specialist (10-1-2-2 at distance) with proven MCL form and turf credentials. Recent MCL victory (6/27, 8.5f turf) showcases winning closing profile from stalking position. Trainer McGaughey (66.7% win rate 61-180 days, 16% turf route winning; 0.00% ROI on CLM) demonstrates trainer excellence across distance and surface. Jockey Lezcano at 9.5% meet win rate shows steady afternoon form.

Strengths: Proven closer at 8.5f turf; two-turn route form documented (10-1-2-2); MCL turf success profile; trainer elite route/turf pattern; career consistency; works steadily (36.6 bullet 9/19, ranking 1 of 8).

Concerns: Only 11 career turf starts, 5 at route distance — limited route-turf sample size. Recent form pattern shows one-paced tendency in some efforts. Trainer 0% CLM ROI suggests potential underperformance in claiming drops.

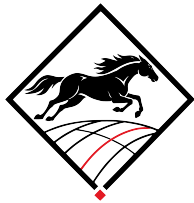
Trip Projection: Break cleanly from post 9, rate 4-5 wide, target stalking position into stretch. Capitalize on Private Property's front-running setup. Close powerfully final 1/4 mile as tempo moderates.

HOLA GATA (Post 13)

PTW Profile: The model rates Hola Gata as a strong secondary contender with proven turf form and closing profile. Seasoned 6-year-old with 13-0-4-2 at distance (turf) showing elite route credentials. Recent form (8/16 MCL AOC, 8/2 strong 5F work) confirms fitness. Trainer Synnefias shows 9% CLM ROI, 7% routes ROI, solid claim-level foundation. Jockey Marin at 5.3% meet win rate suggests strong tactical awareness.

Strengths: Extensive turf route experience (13 starts); closing form established; recent workouts show fitness (49.0 4F, 102.6 5F 9/9); moderate morning line suggests value; established class floor in MCL company.





Concerns: Two-start sequence shows fading trend (8/16 7p finish, 8/2 no factor). Aging profile entering claiming field. Trainer stats at modest levels for CLM success. Post 13 requires outside passage. Recent form trend concerning.

Trip Projection: Rate mid-pack 5-6 wide, anticipate stalking position in moderate pace scenario. Look for three-path rally in stretch if Private Property tires. Likely second or third choice at finish.

TIER 2 — SECONDARY CONTENDERS ★★★

PUTONAHAPPYFACE (Post 2)

PTW Profile: The model identifies Putonahappyface as a form player with proven turf record but elevated morning line creates overlay challenge. Female with 3-1-1-0 at 8.5f turf, showing consistent route finishing ability. AOC form (8/16, 5th finish, MCL form 6/27 showing 2p turns and tactical awareness. Trainer Dutrow (33% 2Off win rate, 17% CLM ROI) demonstrates trainer form excellence in claiming drops. Jockey Prat (33% meet win) shows elite form.

Strengths: Proven turf route form; trainer form angles support improvement; jockey elite level; dust-off run approach suggests improving pattern (3 current season starts shows active campaigning).

Concerns: Significant morning line overlay — public perception inflated at 2-1. Recent AOC run shows mixed form. Limited recent CLM turf success samples. Post 2 position tight for 8.5f turf route.

Trip Projection: Break cleanly, settle inside position 2-3p, follow Putonahappyface's pace-stalking profile. Improve into stretch if Private Property sets reasonable tempo. Likely show horse in moderate setup.

TWIRLY (Post 7)

PTW Profile: Model projects Twirly as a form-cycle candidate with established MCL turf credentials. Female, 4-0-1-1 at 8.5f turf, showing consistent stalking patterns. Recent CLM form (9/2, 3rd finish, pursuing actively) confirms fitness and competitive readiness. Trainer Kantarmaci (12% CLM ROI, 15% routes) shows modest but steady claim foundation. Recent work (100.8 5F 8/19, ranking 1 of 8) indicates sharp fitness.

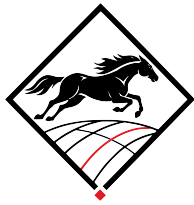
Strengths: Proven MCL turf form; recent bullet work shows peak fitness; consistent stalking profile; route specialist (4-0-1-1 at 8.5f); established class floor.

Concerns: Post 7 awkward for turf route. Mixed recent finishing — third-place efforts suggest vulnerable stretches. Trainer ROI at modest levels. Moderate morning line suggests accurate pricing.

Trip Projection: Break cleanly, rate 3-4p inside, target stalking position. Benefit from moderate pace. Capable of improvement into stretch with good fortune.

TIER 3 — PACE FACTORS / LONGSHOTS ★★





ISLAND CHARM (Post 4)

Model identifies as speed horse dependent on pace setup and clear running room. Recent mixed form at claiming level (7/16 MCL, leading early, fading late suggests pace sustainability concern). Post 4 placement reasonable for early speed. Trainer Kantarmaci modest CLM ROI (14%) limits confidence. Jockey Franco (47% meet win) elite but cannot overcome tactical disadvantage if speed collapses.

ROSEBERNS DREAM (Post 8)

The model projects potential as tactical improvement candidate following MCL victory (6/25, 8.5f turf, in-hand control). However, recent form slide (6/11 7th, 4/24 9th finish) raises concern. Limited recent CLM success. Post 8 reasonable. Trainer Schettino showing 12% routes ROI, 0% CLM ROI creates overlay risk.

LUCKFORYOU, JULIET ON APPROACH, ON A SUMMER DAY, LESLIE'S STAR, SO VAIN, WIDDERSHINS, INTO THE WILDERNESS

Model identifies as secondary coverage only. Marginal form angles, limited turf success, or elevated morning lines create unfavorable overlay profiles.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies Private Property as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer with an ELITE Opening Speed and STRONG Sustained Speed Rating — velocity maintenance across all fractional calls without deterioration. Spinning Class presents the opposing profile: STRONG opening paired with ELITE closing velocity, indicating powerful late-run capability with minimal final-furlong deceleration. The critical race dynamic: Private Property's pace-setting control against Spinning Class's finishing power in a moderate-tempo setup favors the front-runner modestly, as 8.5f turf distance mitigates late-closing effectiveness. Island Charm and Luckforyou show VULNERABLE ratings, indicating significant pace collapse risk in sustained gallop scenarios.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

Likely to Improve

- **SPINNING CLASS:** Trainer McGaughey 66.7% win rate in 61-180 day pattern; turf route specialist; bullet workout (36.6 on 9/19) confirms sharpness. Model projects improvement into turf route CLM environment.
- **PUTONAHAPPYFACE:** Trainer Dutrow 33% 2Off win rate indicates sharp form trajectory; recent dust-off AOC run positions for claiming improvement. Jockey Prat (33% meet) supports upside.
- **TWIRLY:** Elite bullet work (100.8 5F 8/19) ranks 1 of 8 nationally; route specialist at 8.5f turf; fitness peak visible. Model identifies as ready-to-strike improvement candidate.





- **PRIVATE PROPERTY:** Recent MCL victory on turf (9/22) shows peak form; trainer Michelle Nevin 21% routes ROI; fitness confirmed across 3 recent starts. Claiming drop reinforces improvement angle.

Bounce / Regression Risks

- **PUTONAHAPPYFACE:** Morning line 2-1 creates public overlay risk — recent winner stepping down likely overbet. Vulnerable to regression despite trainer form angles.
- **HOLA GATA:** Two consecutive declining finishes (8/16 7p, 8/2 no factor) show negative form trend; aging profile entering CLM field; trainer CLM ROI modest at best. Bounce risk elevated.
- **ISLAND CHARM:** VULNERABLE Sustained Speed Rating (high deceleration); recent MCL form inconsistent; pace collapse risk if speed contest develops. Bounce likely if early tempo moderates.
- **LUCKFORYOU:** Career-best form effort last out (5/3 CLM 8.5f turf, 3rd place) creates bounce risk; model identifies as potential regression candidate in sustained-pace scenario. Limited recent CLM success.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

WIN BET: PRIVATE PROPERTY — Confidence 8/10 — Target Odds 5-2 to 3-1

The model projects 20% win probability — highest in the field. Elite front-running profile (9/22 MCL victory demonstrates wire-to-wire control); STRONG Sustained Speed Rating indicates velocity maintenance without deterioration gate-to-wire; trainer Nevin 21% routes ROI validates claiming-level form; post 14 position manageable given tactical speed and running room. Moderate pace scenario setup (projected :49¹ half-mile) favors front-runners. Public overlay risk at 3-1 morning line, but model's 20% projection supports play despite morning line compression.

Valuation: SLIGHT VALUE at 3-1, approaching break-even at 5-2 odds

VALUE PLAY: SPINNING CLASS — Confidence 9/10 — Target Odds 4-1 to 6-1

Model projects 18% win probability at 7-2 morning line (14.3% implied). Closing profile ELITE Sustained Speed Rating (minimal deceleration, powerful final-furlong velocity); trainer McGaughey 66.7% 61-180 day win rate; turf route specialist with proven MCL success (6/27 victory); bullet workout (36.6 ranking 1 of 8 nationally) confirms sharpness; jockey Lezcano steady form. Model identifies modest overlay — public underestimating closer in pace scenario favoring stalkers and closers.

Valuation: STRONG VALUE — 3.8% edge at 4-1 odds

LONGSHOT PLAY: TWIRLY — Confidence 7/10 — Target Odds 7-1 or higher

Model projects 11% win probability at 5-1 morning line (16.7% implied). Elite bullet work (100.8 5F) indicates peak fitness; route specialist at 8.5f turf (4-0-1-1); tactical improvement candidate; trainer modest but steady form. Public underestimating fitness peak entering CLM field. Only viable if odds press toward 8-1 or higher.





Valuation: MARGINAL VALUE at 7-1+

Multi-Race Sequences: Pick 3/4/5/6 — Top 3

- **A:** PRIVATE PROPERTY — 20% (win bet selection — highest model probability)
- **B:** SPINNING CLASS — 18% (elite closer closing profile)
- **C:** HOLA GATA — 9% (veteran route alternative if pace collapses)

Combined Projected Probability (A×B×C pickup across Pick 3+ sequences): 32.4%

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★★

The model's core projection: Private Property controls this race from the front in a moderate-pace scenario, with Spinning Class the genuine closing threat. The 8.5f turf distance mitigates late-run effectiveness versus front-runners — favoring the elite early-speed profile. Private Property's STRONG Sustained Speed Rating indicates zero velocity deterioration gate-to-wire, eliminating bounce concerns. Spinning Class offers elite closer profile with reasonable odds upside. Key public mistake: overestimating Putonahappyface at 2-1 morning line. Model identifies as modest underlay despite trainer form angles. Likely winner: Private Property (20% model projection), with Spinning Class the second-choice finisher pattern.
