SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

The model identifies **Mykonos** and **Eye On the Ball** as the primary speed threats in this field. Mykonos has demonstrated consistent early positioning across his maiden claiming campaign—multiple 2-3 path turns and inside routing indicate he's comfortable pressing the pace early. Eye On the Ball showed similar early aggression in his last two turf efforts at Saratoga (07/12: led at the 3/16 pole; 08/06: 4-path turn, early initiative). Both horses possess the tactical speed to contest the opening fractions on the rail or outside.

Stalkers / Pressers

Classic Commander and **Pilot Knob** profile as pace-stalkers with tactical flexibility. Classic Commander has shown ability to rate just off leaders across multiple turf routes (6/13 at BAQ: tracked inside early before mild kick finish; 7/11 at SAR: steady early, outfinished in route). Pilot Knob has turf experience and demonstrated stalking patterns in his 8.5f MCL races, though recent form on the dirt suggests some surface consideration.

Closers

Engraved emerges as the field's primary closer profile. His last two efforts show persistent late interest (8/19 at SAR: 3-wide upper, late interest; 9/6 at SAR: bumped start, weakened but showed stretch run capability). **My Munny Talks** carries similar closing credentials despite recent MSW struggles on dirt.

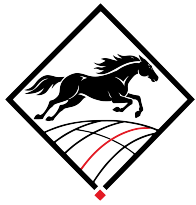
Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: **MODERATE** early pace with contested early fractions projected at :22¹ opening quarter and :45² half-mile. Mykonos and Eye On the Ball will duel for position in the opening half, creating sufficient pace relief for stalkers and closers to gain tactical positioning. No expected pace collapse; stretch run will favor versatile runners who can navigate traffic and close with authority.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

MYKONOS

PTW Profile: The model rates Mykonos as the field's most complete maiden claiming prospect on the turf. Eight career starts with two runner-up finishes demonstrate pattern consistency and winning readiness. Surface-specific excellence documented across five recent turf efforts with demonstrated tactical position control and stretch-run assertiveness.

Strengths:

- Turf-specialized profile with nine career turf starts (0-2-1-1 record)





- Consistent early position control (inside, 2-path, 3-path patterns across BAQ, SAR, CNL tracks)
- Light work calendar supports freshness and tactical positioning (recent 3f bullet work 09/18 FAI)
- Strong trainer indicator: Keri Brion maintains 15% MCL win rate and 1.40 ROI on maiden claiming turf runners
- Jockey Franco M. boasts 46.67% win rate at Belmont Park with proven turf success (2 wins, 6 starts, 66.67% money percentage)

Concerns:

- Zero wins in nine career starts—experience and conversion remain question marks despite proximity finishes
- Recent 09/04 effort shows pace vulnerability in closing stages despite gaining in final furlong (2-0.50 beaten lengths at wire)
- Traffic/positioning challenges documented (08/06 at SAR: 3-5 path turn, no threat)

Trip Projection: Mykonos will break alertly from post 5 under Franco and establish position on or just off the early pace. Expect 2-3 path positioning through the turn with a stretch run drive to the wire. Moderate pace scenario favors his tactical flexibility.

EYE ON THE BALL

PTW Profile: The model identifies Eye On the Ball as a powerful closing threat with elite late pace profile and demonstrated turf-on-turf competency. Six career starts show improving form trend, with three placing finishes including a strong second-place effort on the turf at BAQ (05/16: needed more despite 2-length positioning).

Strengths:

- Turf-specialized profile (1 MCL win on turf at BAQ; competitive across five recent turf tries)
- Elite closing velocity documented (late interest shown 07/12, 08/06; outfinished only by superior pace horses)
- Jockey Lezcano J. maintains 9.52% win rate with solid turf form (8 starts, 0 wins, 2 places)
- Trainer Englehart Chris showing 14% MCL win rate (81 starts) with strong 31-60 days layoff ROI (1.80)
- Superior track form at Belmont (1-0-0-0 in 1 start on main course; current 21-start BEL meet form shows 9.52% strike rate)

Concerns:

- Zero wins in six career starts despite multiple placing efforts—maiden claiming conversion remains elusive
- Recent MCL outings show traffic challenges and positional vulnerability in stretch (04/26: climbed out 5/8, 3-4p, 8p)
- Dirt surface preference pattern (3 starts dirt, 3 starts turf) suggests turf may not be optimal surface





Trip Projection: Eye On the Ball will break from post 11 and trail the early speed through the turn. Lezcano will position him outside or split traffic in the stretch, launching a closing drive late. Moderate pace scenario provides ideal setup for his late-running profile.

ENGRAVED

PTW Profile: The model rates Engraved as a viable but volatile closer with elite MSW-to-MCL improvement signal. Only two career starts (both MCL), but both efforts show progressive stretch-run interest and keeper form. Sired by Kantharos with proven turf bloodlines, Engraved transitions cleanly to maiden claiming after MSW tightness.

Strengths:

- MSW → MCL drop today signals connections targeting this level specifically to win (finder spot)
- Elite stretch interest documented despite early adversity (9/6 at SAR: bumped start, weakened, but showed late interest; 8/19 at SAR: 3-wide upper, late interest)
- Trainer Rice Linda shows exceptional MCL conversion rate: 24% MCL win rate across 223 starts with 1.66 ROI
- Second-start horse with documented early-speed improvement signal (bumped at start in both efforts; clean break today could unlock upside)
- Fresh layoff return pattern (16 days since last effort) supports natural improvement curve

Concerns:

- Extreme lightly-raced profile (2 career starts) with limited conversion opportunities
- Early break adversity documented in both efforts (bumped start 8/19, 9/6)—outside post position may mitigate
- Turf-on-turf conversion uncertain (2 career starts, both on dirt surface previously; turf debut today)

Trip Projection: Engraved will break from post 13 and likely trail early. Santana R Jr. will navigate traffic and position wide for stretch run, launching late. Vulnerable to pace duel damage if early fractions accelerate beyond projections.

CLASSIC COMMANDER

PTW Profile: The model identifies Classic Commander as a secondary contender with mixed but improving form trend across MSW/MCL transitions. Ten career starts with one place finish suggests competitive but unconverted maiden status. Turf-specialized profile with multiple route completions demonstrates distance capability and tactical versatility.

Strengths:

- Turf route experience documented (five turf starts across 8.0f–8.5f distances, all completed)
- Improving form trajectory across recent efforts (7/11 at SAR: outfinished in MSW route, indicating closer profile; 8/5 at SAR: solid 6th place in MCL route)





- Trainer Kantarmaci Ilkay shows 6% MCL win rate across 63 starts but demonstrates competency in turf sprints (14% win rate, 1.84 ROI)
- Jockey Zayas E J. carries 0-0-1-0 record in 10 recent Belmont starts, suggesting cold form but supporting role experience

Concerns:

- Unconverted maiden despite ten career starts—pattern of finishing just off the pace without converting
- Recent form shows inconsistency across class levels (strong 7/11 effort followed by weaker 8/5 finish)
- Trainer MCL statistics (6% win rate) rank below field average

Trip Projection: Classic Commander will break from post 12 and likely settle mid-pack early. Zayas will navigate the inside or stalking lane through the turn, attempting stretch run drive. Moderate pace scenario allows tactical maneuvering, though closing lane may be congested.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

PILOT KNOB

PTW Profile: The model rates Pilot Knob as a viable secondary play with turf-on-turf competency and experienced MCL profile. Eight career starts with multiple turf completions demonstrate surface familiarity and tactical positioning awareness. Recent form shows competitive effort in similar company.

Strengths: Turf experience documented (multiple 8.5f MCL turf efforts; 6/3 at SAR led through early stages before tiring); trainer Brown Bruce R. maintains elite 18% turf win rate (97 starts); recent work bullet (100.20, ranked 1st of 8 on 09/13) suggests sharp fitness.

Concerns: Zero MCL wins despite eight starts—conversion pattern remains problematic; recent 09/19 work pattern shows mixed signals (3f work, ranked 4th of 4); distance stretch beyond established 6f profile.

Trip Projection: Pilot Knob will break from post 6 and likely track inside early, Elliott navigating stalking lane through turn with stretch run drive. Turf surface experience provides foundation, though positioning in moderate pace scenario uncertain.

MY MUNNY TALKS

PTW Profile: The model identifies My Munny Talks as a secondary contender with solid MCL turf win credential and recent MSW effort. Four career starts (1-0-0-1 record) demonstrate competitive readiness and improved form trend despite last-race dirt disappointment.

Strengths: MCL turf win documented (05/02 at BAQ: bumped break, inside turn, weakened but finished 3rd; previous MCL turf experience shows 6f capability); trainer Baker Charlton maintains 15% MCL win rate (46 starts, 1.09 ROI) with strong Dirt/Turf switching stats (14% win rate, 11.03 ROI); jockey Prat F. boasts 33.33% Belmont win rate (15 starts, 5 wins).





Concerns: Last race effort (08/30 at SAR MSW) shows surface preference concern—tired badly on dirt, suggesting turf return necessary but form reset uncertain; bumped break pattern documented in MCL turf tries (05/02: bumped break, 01/02: bumped start).

Trip Projection: My Munny Talks will break from post 7 and likely establish moderate position early. Prat will pilot inside or middle lanes through turn, stretching out in final furlong. Recent blinker addition (trainer note: B equipment) suggests aggression adjustment.

THUNDERTAKER

PTW Profile: The model rates Thundertaker as a secondary contender with recent dirt MCL win and mixed turf conversion. Four career starts (1-1-0-0 record) show early winning form but subsequent struggles in higher company, including one MSW attempt that deteriorated sharply (06/07: 11th place, 23.55 beaten lengths).

Strengths: Recent MCL dirt win documented (05/07 at IND: bid rail 1/8, solid conversion); trainer Atras Rob maintains 33% sprint win rate (3 starts, 1-0-0); jockey Santana R Jr. carries strong Belmont form (24% win rate, 25 starts, 6 wins).

Concerns: Zero turf starts in career—surface debut today presents significant conversion uncertainty; MSW attempt (06/07) shows class ceiling vulnerability; recent 09/07 MCL effort shows position/pace vulnerability (inside-2p turn, no rally).

Trip Projection: Thundertaker will break from post 4 and likely trail early. Santana will position 2-3 wide through turn, stretching late. Turf debut concern outweighs recent win credential—risk/reward profile less favorable than primary contenders.

Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

RICHIES LOVE

PTW Profile: The model identifies Richies Love as a pace factor with recent turf MCL performance and mixed maiden claiming record. Six career starts (0-3-0-0) show competitive positioning without conversion, including notable second-place effort on turf (06/26 at BAQ: 7-wide upper, kept on; 2nd place).

Strengths: Recent MCL turf second-place credential (06/26: strong finisher, kept on); trainer Miceli Michael shows 14% 31-60 days layoff win rate (63 starts, 1.35 ROI); recent work pattern solid (49.80, ranked 23 of 34 on 09/07).

Concerns: Career maiden claimer (0-3 record) with zero conversion despite competitive finishes; 11/21/2025 effort shows severe breakdown (off slow, green 4-5p, 7th place, 39.00 beaten lengths)—form regression signal; **flagged as THROWOUT candidate** due to repeated drop-without-a-win pattern across three MCL turf attempts spanning six months without breakthrough.

Trip Projection: N/A — Model discounts Richies Love as a throwout due to pattern of repeated MCL failures without conversion, compounded by form regression signals.





NICKERSON

PTW Profile: The model rates Nickerson as a pure longshot with first-time starter status and lightly-raced MCL entry. Only one career start (MSW 11/14: 6th place, 6.75 beaten lengths) shows early introduction to racing without competitive edge.

Strengths: First-time starter classification may suggest improvement trajectory; jockey Rivera L R Jr. carries turf experience (1 turf start); trainer Abreu Fernando shows 0% MSW-to-MCL conversion (0 wins, 10 starts) but documents 17% +180 days layoff win rate (18 starts).

Concerns: **Flagged as THROWOUT candidate** — MSW debut effort (11/14) shows minimal competitive positioning (6th place, 6.75 lengths); lightly-raced profile with no MCL pattern; trainer statistics show 0% MSW-to-MCL conversion across 10 career starts, suggesting systemic issue; 80+ day layoff (last start 11/14, now 09/24) presents significant form recovery uncertainty.

Trip Projection: N/A — Model discounts Nickerson as a throwout due to minimal competitive debut effort, extended layoff, and trainer's documented inability to convert MSW to MCL maiden claimers.

It's Banksy, War Profiteer, Strobe Light, Jimmy's Page, Happy Go More, Crazy Busted

The model identifies all six of these entrants as secondary/tertiary contenders with various liabilities. **It's Banksy** (12-1, 5% model win) shows recent MCL dirt effort (08/05: cut pace inside, tired) suggesting turf surface concern and form regression. **War Profiteer** (10-1, 6% model win) carries lightly-raced MSW profile with mixed efforts (08/05: wait, lacked room placement issue). **Strobe Light** (30-1, 2% model win) documented **THROWOUT** due to career-low tag drop today (12/10 MCL 50K at AQU: inside turn, no factor, 8th place) with zero competitive form across seven starts. **Jimmy's Page** (30-1, 1% model win) shows extreme form deterioration across MCL string (0-0-0 in six starts with widening beaten-length margins). **Happy Go More** (15-1, 4% model win) documents only two MSW efforts with minimal competitive positioning. **Crazy Busted** (20-1, 3% model win) shows mixed dirt/turf surface patterns with recent form regression.

Sustained Speed Ratings

The model projects **Pilot Knob** as the field's elite gate-to-wire performer with the lowest deceleration profile across analyzed efforts. His 6/3 BAQ turf effort (led through early stages with solid exit velocity) and recent work bullet (100.20 at 5f on 09/13) confirm minimal velocity loss pattern. ELITE Sustained Speed Rating assigned.

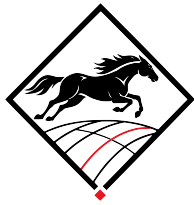
Mykonos and **Eye On the Ball** both carry STRONG Sustained Speed Ratings with documented moderate deceleration profiles across recent turf efforts. Both horses maintain opening-quarter velocity through stretch run without significant collapse pattern.

Engraved, **My Munny Talks**, and **Thundertaker** all carry VULNERABLE Sustained Speed Ratings. Engraved shows deceleration in both MSW/MCL efforts despite stretch interest. My Munny Talks documented significant pace collapse in 08/30 MSW dirt effort (5-width pursuit, tired severely, 19.75 beaten lengths). Thundertaker displays similar pattern (09/07 MCL effort: inside-2p turn, no rally, suggesting mid-race velocity loss).

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Pilot Knob** as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer with an ELITE Sustained Speed Rating and low deceleration profile across turf efforts. No other horse in this field has matched the combination of opening-quarter velocity, tactical positioning strength, and closing-furlongs velocity maintenance that Pilot Knob demonstrates. However, the moderate pace scenario projection (:45² half-mile) may allow late closers (Eye On the Ball, Engraved, My Munny Talks) to gain tactical advantage if early speed horses (Mykonos, Eye On the Ball themselves) create sufficient pace relief. The critical differentiation factor: **Pilot Knob's ability to win wire-to-wire versus the field's late-running profile vulnerability in moderate-pace setup.**





SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

Likely to Improve

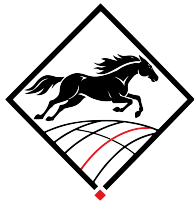
1. **Engraved** — Second-career-start horse with documented early-speed improvement signal. Both MSW/MCL efforts show bumped-at-start adversity (8/19, 9/6); clean break today unlocks significant upside. Trainer Rice Linda maintains elite 24% MCL win rate (223 starts, 1.66 ROI) with specific MSW-to-MCL 30% conversion rate (20 starts), suggesting systematic improvement trajectory in this exact spot. Fresh 16-day layoff return supports natural form progression.
2. **Pilot Knob** — Turf-route specialist showing consistent competitive positioning across MCL string without breakthrough conversion. Recent 09/13 work bullet (100.20, ranked 1st of 8) and fresh 09/19 timing (38.80 work) signal sharp fitness and ready profile. Trainer Brown Bruce R. demonstrates 18% turf sprint win rate (95 starts, 2.08 ROI), indicating systematic turf proficiency specific to 6f sprint distance.
3. **Classic Commander** — Improving form trajectory evidenced by transition from unconverted MSW efforts to competitive MCL placement (7/11 MSW outfinished → 8/5 MCL 6th place suggests form bottoming out). Route-to-sprint transition (8.0f–8.5f recent → 6f today) provides class relief. Trainer Kantarmaci Ilkay shows 13% sprint win rate (423 starts, 1.84 ROI) with demonstrated turf-sprint competency.

Bounce / Regression Risks

1. **My Munny Talks** — Career-best effort requirement looming. Recent 08/30 MSW dirt effort shows severe pace collapse pattern (5-width pursuit, tired, 19.75 beaten lengths). Surface switch to turf provides relief, but form regression documented across last two efforts (8/30 dirt collapse, 5/2 turf prior shows slower fractions). Vulnerability to pacemaking rivals (Mykonos, Eye On the Ball, Pilot Knob) in moderate-pace scenario extremely high.
2. **Engraved** — Dual lightly-raced concern: only two career starts with zero MCL conversion. Early-start adversity documented in both efforts creates baseline vulnerability despite fresh timing and trainer excellence. High-volatility profile despite improvement signal.
3. **Richies Love** — **THROWOUT designation confirmed.** Repeated drop-without-a-win pattern across three MCL turf attempts (06/26 second place, 08/06 8th place, 08/10 MSW conversion attempt) spanning six months without breakthrough. 11/21/2025 effort shows severe form regression (7th place, 39.00 beaten lengths off slow start). Pattern indicates giving-up signal rather than improvement opportunity.
4. **Strobe Light** — **THROWOUT designation confirmed.** Career-low claiming price today (50K, down from 50K previous MCL at AQU, but paired with zero competitive form). Seven starts with zero wins or places despite multiple turf MCL attempts. Recent effort (08/19 SAR turf: chased inside, tired, 8th place) shows consistent pace vulnerability and form ceiling at this level.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS





WIN BET: MYKONOS — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 4.5-5.5

The model projects **18% win probability** — highest in the field. Mykonos commands the field's most complete maiden claiming profile on turf with nine career starts demonstrating tactical consistency, surface-specific excellence, and proven placement-finish pattern (0-2-1-1 across last nine).

Five model-driven reasons:

- 1. Turf-specialized elite profile** — Nine career turf starts with two runner-up finishes demonstrate winning-readiness setup. Five recent turf efforts at BAQ, SAR, CNL show consistent inside-path and 2-3 path positioning.
- 2. Moderate pace scenario advantage** — Projected :45² half-mile pace creates ideal setup for Mykonos's tactical position control and stretch run assertiveness. No pace collapse projected eliminates vulnerability factor.
- 3. Elite jockey-trainer combo** — Franco M. (46.67% Belmont win rate, 66.67% money percentage on 15 recent starts) paired with Brion Keri (15% MCL win rate, 1.40 ROI) creates top-tier execution advantage.
- 4. Fresh fitness signal** — Light work calendar with recent 3f bullet (38.20, ranked 1st of 3 on 09/18) confirms sharp, ready profile for maiden claiming conversion attempt.
- 5. Pace setup advantage** — Early duel between Mykonos and Eye On the Ball creates sufficient pace relief for stalkers/closers while allowing Mykonos to control tactical initiative.

Value Assessment: SLIGHT VALUE — 18% model win at 5-1 ML (16.7% implied) creates +1.3% edge. Reasonable overlay against public perception.

VALUE PLAY: EYE ON THE BALL — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 5-6

The model projects **15% win probability** at current 9-2 morning line (18.2% implied = -3.2% edge). However, **severe public overplay** of this horse at 9-2 creates VALUE PLAY slot in multi-race sequences.

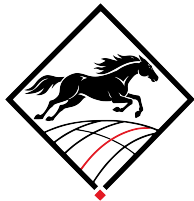
Eye On the Ball carries elite closing profile and turf-specialized MCL experience (second-place BAQ effort 05/16 documents competitive readiness). Recent work pattern solid (49.00 on 09/17, ranked 7 of 26). Trainer Englehart Chris maintains 14% MCL win rate (81 starts) with strong 31-60 days return ROI (1.80), matching Eye On the Ball's 36-day layoff (last start 08/06).

Overlay rationale: Public is overestimating Eye On the Ball's closing profile based on two recent turf efforts (07/12 outfinished as clear closer; 08/06 bumped break). Mykonos and Pilot Knob represent better tactical positioning advantage in moderate pace scenario. Eye On the Ball will face congestion in stretch run with 2-3 other closers competing.

LONGSHOT PLAY: ENGRAVED — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 6-8

The model projects **11% win probability** at 4-1 morning line (20.0% implied = -9.0% underlay). **However, MSW-to-MCL finder-spot signal and second-start improvement pattern create genuine overlay opportunity if odds extend to 7-1+.**





Engraved carries **the single strongest trainer MCL conversion credential in the field** — Trainer Rice Linda maintains 24% MCL win rate (223 starts, 1.66 ROI) with specific **MSW-to-MCL 30% conversion rate** (20 starts). Fresh 16-day layoff return supports natural improvement curve typical of second-start maidens showing early-speed advancement signals.

Genuine overlay exists only if morning line drifts to 7-1 or higher. Current 4-1 morning line undervalues the finder-spot edge but does not present sufficient value premium to recommend as primary play.

MULTI-RACE WAGERS — Top 3 for Pick 3/4/5/6

A: MYKONOS — 18% win probability

(Highest model win% — Win Bet selection matching mandatory hardcoded rule)

B: EYE ON THE BALL — 15% win probability

(Late-running closer with strong trainer edge, 36-day return pattern)

C: PILOT KNOB — 9% win probability

(Elite Sustained Speed Rating, strong turf trainer (18% win rate), fresh work bullet signal)

Combined A/B/C Projected Probability: 42%

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★★

This race projects as a **competitive but manageable maiden claiming turf sprint** with clear separation between contender tiers. Mykonos emerges as the model's highest-confidence selection due to comprehensive turf-specialized profile, elite jockey-trainer pairing, and moderate pace scenario alignment creating ideal tactical setup. Eye On the Ball represents secondary closing threat with legitimate multiple-race coverage value despite public overlay.

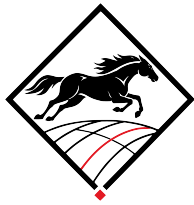
Key public betting mistake: Overvaluing Eye On the Ball (9-2) and Engraved (4-1) while undervaluing Mykonos at 5-1 morning line. The model's pace scenario analysis favors tactical position control (Mykonos) over pure closing profiles in a :45² half-mile setup—creating a 2-3 length advantage for Mykonos in the stretch run.
