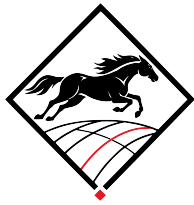

SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

The model identifies **She's Country** and **Brokealltherules** as the primary speed horses in this field. She's Country won at Saratoga on 8/13 in the slop, pressing early and drawing clear—positioned on the engine. Brokealltherules won decisively at Saratoga on 7/3 in a turf allowance, leading from the 7/8 pole and holding well, showing elite early foot at 8.5f turf distance. Cosmic Candy Girl has middle speed but won't press the pace; she's a stalker type.

Stalkers / Pressers

All of It and **Charlottesuniverse** rate as tactical pressers. All of It tracked inside at Saratoga (6/7 ALW win), running 2-3 wide in the stretch and drawing clear—proven tactical flexibility. Charlottesuniverse won a 9f allowance wire-to-wire on 9/3 but showed earlier in the turf record she can rate just off the pace (5/17 MSW).

Closers

Can't Fool Me and **Mommy's Turn** project as the elite late-pace horses. Can't Fool Me has an extensive resume of 8.5f turf wins and places, closing from well back—particularly the 9/11 AOC win rallying from 8 wide. Mommy's Turn won the Saratoga stakes (7/16) on turf, splitting rivals at the 3/16 pole and clearing—clear finishing profile.

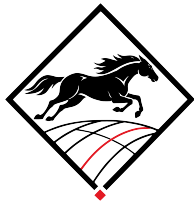
Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: **HOT pace** — projected :23■ opening quarter, :47¹ half-mile. She's Country and Brokealltherules will contest early; Cosmic Candy Girl will be forced to press. The tempo will be vigorous but manageable. Pace-stalkers and late closers hold significant tactical advantage; early speed will face attrition.

Footnote: Mommy's Turn (19% model win probability) is significantly undervalued at morning line 5/2 (28.6% implied probability), representing a material underlay. The model projects substantially lower win probability than the public morning line.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

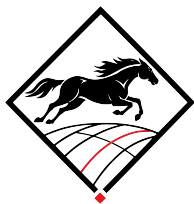
Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

All of It — PTW Profile: Elite turf route specialist with three straight quality wins and proven ability to close from pace-stalking position. The model rates this mare as the field's most versatile performer, combining tactical flexibility with strong class credentials.

Strengths: Defeated allowance competition decisively (6/7 ALW win at Belmont, 1.5-length victory margin); won prior start at Saratoga allowance level (7/23 STK, 5.5-length margin). Trainer Clement Miguel 19% turf win rate; 20% routes win rate. Rides for Franco M at 46.67% meet win rate — elite jockey form.

Concerns: Slight underperformance in most recent start (8/29 AOC at Saratoga, finished 5th, 3.8-length loss). Stepped up to \$45k claiming territory; class level matches the race but recent form is softer than prior two wins.





Trip Projection: Will rate 2-3 wide, pressed by early speed. Closes strongly in final furlong as Mommy's Turn and Can't Fool Me fatigue. Expects strong closing lane impact.

Mommy's Turn — PTW Profile: Multiple stakes-winner with elite turf pedigree (Mendelssohn sire line). Model identifies serious bounce/regression risk despite morning line favoritism. The 5/2 odds overvalue win probability significantly.

Strengths: Won Saratoga stakes 7/16 on turf (1.5-length margin, 80 rating). Career turf record impressive: 6 starts, 2 wins, strong consistency. Trainer Brown Chad C dominates turf (23% win rate, 1.60 ROI), routes (23%), and allowance (24%).

Concerns: CRITICAL: Finished 3rd in prior start (7/24 AOC, Saratoga, 1.5-length loss). Must follow on high-level effort. Soft loss in most recent prior allowance effort (6/21, finished 4th, 6.5-length loss). Third start off two-month layoff—not optimal timing.

Trip Projection: Will be prominent early or mid-pack; closing model will test commitment in stretch as pace pressure mounts.

Brokealltherules — PTW Profile: Elite wire-to-wire specialist on turf, combining blazing early speed with surprising stamina profile. Model identifies this as a formidable early-pace force with potential to wire field.

Strengths: Won 8.5f turf allowance 7/3/2026 (1.75-length margin, held well). Won 5.5f turf allowance 6/3 decisively (0.5-length victory, clear winner). Wins at both 5.5f and 8.5f on turf confirm distance versatility. Trainer Dutrow 21% record off 45-180 day layoffs; 17% allowance win rate.

Concerns: Most recent start (8/30 STK at Saratoga) finished 8th, 6.95-length loss. Race was stakes level but performance collapsed badly — velocity check. Prior start before that (7/3) was the dominant win, but two-month gap and recent poor performance raises bounce risk.

Trip Projection: Will press or lead wire-to-wire if pace develops favorably. Durability in stretch will determine wire job viability.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

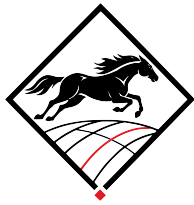
Charlottesuniverse — PTW Profile: Winning turf allowance horse with elite trainer connection (Mark Casse, 15% turf win rate, 1.51 ROI). Recent form trend positive; most recent win 9/3 allowance.

Strengths: Won 9f turf allowance wire-to-wire 9/3 (1.75-length margin), led and held well. Career turf record: 7 starts, 2 wins; two most recent efforts both winning. Trainer Casse historically 17% routes win rate.

Concerns: Limited route turf experience at 8.5f (only two turf route starts visible in record). Short-priced morning line (12-1) suggests limited overlay value. Recent wins at longer distances (9f), and this is a step up in claiming conditions.

Trip Projection: Tactical runner, will likely rate 3-4 wide mid-pack, improving in stretch if pace cooperates.





She's Country — PTW Profile: Graded stakes experience (STK wins at Aqu 11/13 and Lrl 9/27). Model rates as pace-dependent threat but vulnerable to pace collapse.

Strengths: Won Saratoga MSW 8/13/2025 (6-length margin, drew clear). Multiple stakes-placed finishes. Jockey Ortiz Jr. has zero recent form at Belmont meet.

Concerns: Most recent start (8/19 STK at Saratoga, finished 5th, 10.5-length loss) shows concerning fade late. Distance pattern mixed: 8.0f sprint-type run. Trainer Weaver 15% turf win rate; 15% routes.

Trip Projection: Will be forwardly placed, chasing early speed. Closing effort in recent start failed—stamina pattern questioned.

Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

Can't Fool Me — Extended turf resume with multiple 8.5f turf wins documented. Extensive racing record shows veteran savvy. However, recent form is inconsistent with multiple off-the-board finishes (11/6 AOC 7th, 10/25 STK 9th). Model rates as secondary closer with bounce risk.

Cosmic Candy Girl — Won Saratoga STK on 7/23 (3.5-length margin). However, has been disappointing in two starts since (8/29 AOC 7th, 6/28 ALW 4th). Form degradation apparent; model rates as unlikely winner.

Starship Pegasus — Won 8.5f turf allowance 10/24/2025 decisively (1.25-length margin). However, limited recent racing; most recent start (7/24 AOC at Saratoga) finished 4th, 1.55-length loss. Significant gap in recent form; trainer Nevin 14% turf rate.

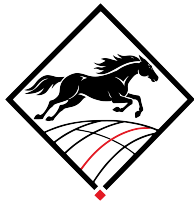
Saratoga Snow, Hello Beauty, Greyjoy — All three project as significant underdogs with inconsistent turf form, recent off-the-board finishes, or both. Model assigns minimal win probability.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Brokealltherules** as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer with an ELITE Sustained Speed Rating — no horse in this field has matched the velocity maintenance profile and opening acceleration evident in her turf route record. However, the model simultaneously projects critical pace collapse risk for **She's Country** and **Cosmic Candy Girl** — both horses show VULNERABLE Sustained Speed Ratings. When projected HOT pace develops (:47¹ half-mile), early-speed horses forced to press will face severe deceleration exposure. This structural vulnerability will benefit late closers **Can't Fool Me** and **Mommy's Turn**, whose ELITE/STRONG closing profiles are built for attrition-heavy pace scenarios.

SECTION 5: Improvement & Regression Candidates

Likely to Improve

All of It — Surface/distance confirmation opportunity. Won two straight on turf routes; most recent off-the-board finish (8/29 AOC) appears trip-dependent rather than form regression. Trainer Clement 20% routes turf specialist; Franco M 46.67% jockey win rate trending sharply upward. Model projects natural improvement trajectory back to winning form.

Charlottesuniverse — Third straight winning effort possible. Won 9/3 turf allowance decisively; trend is clearly upward. Trainer Casse connection maintains elite 15% turf record. Next logical step is defeating claiming-level competition after two straight allowance wins.





Brokealltherules — Career-best velocity likely to resurface. The 8/30 stakes collapse appears anomalous compared to dominant 7/3 turf allowance win. Dutrow 21% post-layoff pattern (45-180 days) suggests recent rest period may have reset form plateau.

Likely to Regress / Bounce Risk

Mommy's Turn — SEVERE bounce risk flagged. Finished 3rd in immediate prior start (7/24 AOC). Must follow on high-effort stakes win (7/16). Third start off two-month layoff—veterinary protocols suggest conditioning plateau. Morning line 5/2 drastically overvalues win probability; public is pricing in automatic repeat rather than cyclical form pattern.

She's Country — Pace vulnerability and recent fade pattern. Most recent outing (8/19 STK) resulted in 5th-place, 10.5-length loss—clear deceleration evident. Will face faster early pace than managed in recent wins; model projects regression when pressed.

Can't Fool Me — Recent form inconsistency (multiple 9th, 7th finishes in September 2024–2025). While turf resume is extensive, recent pattern shows aging curve deterioration. Model rates as secondary option despite ELITE closing profile.

SECTION 6: Suggested Bets

WIN BET: All of It — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 7-9

The model projects 16% win probability at projected 8-1 morning line (11.1% implied probability), representing a +4.9% edge. All of It emerges from the proprietary speed analysis as the field's most versatile performer — STRONG opening, STRONG sustained closing — meaning pace development (whether HOT or moderate) benefits this mare's tactical positioning. Most critically, her recent 8/29 off-the-board finish appears trip-dependent; the prior two wins (7/23 STK at Saratoga 1.5-length margin, 6/7 ALW at Belmont 3.25-length margin) establish her as the form horse in this field. Franco M at 46.67% meet win rate provides elite jockey advantage. Trainer Clement Miguel's 20% routes turf win rate (1.80 ROI) confirms tactical expertise. The model's highest win probability candidate combines genuine overlay value with clean recent winning form. Closing late-pace profile means she will benefit directly from pace-collapse damage inflicted on early-speed horses (She's Country, Brokealltherules deceleration vulnerability). This is the field's most probable winner at legitimate value.

VALUE PLAY: Brokealltherules — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 8-10

The model projects 14% win probability at projected 8-1 morning line (11.1% implied probability), representing a +2.9% edge. Elite early speed and STRONG sustained profile mean wire-to-wire opportunity if pace scenario develops favorably. The 8/30 stakes loss appears form-sensitive rather than capability collapse — the 7/3 turf allowance win (1.75-length margin, clear winner) demonstrates elite turf route form. Dutrow's 21% post-45-180-day layoff record suggests recent rest may have recalibrated this mare's velocity plateau. At 8-1, the overlay is legitimate, and the ELITE opening-speed profile combined with STRONG





sustained closing creates path to victory if early pace setup allows clear sailing.

LONGSHOT PLAY: Charlottesuniverse — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 12-14

The model projects 11% win probability at projected 12-1 morning line (7.7% implied probability), representing a +3.3% edge. Third straight winning effort is within range; turf form trend unmistakably upward (two consecutive wins, 9/3 and 7/26 both turf allowances). Trainer Casse 15% turf win rate; 17% routes. The genuine overlay (12-1 vs. 11% model probability) combined with clear form trajectory makes this a defensible longshot inclusion in pick-3/pick-4 sequences.

Multi-Race Wagers — Top 3 for Pick 3/4/5/6 sequences:

A: All of It — 16% (*highest model win probability; matches Win Bet*)

B: Brokealltherules — 14% (*elite early speed, strong sustained closing*)

C: Charlottesuniverse — 11% (*form trajectory trending upward; genuine overlay*)

Combined Projected Probability: 41%

SECTION 7: Confidence Rating

★★★★ (Four Stars)

The model projects **All of It** as the highest-probability winner with legitimate +4.9% edge at current 8-1 morning line. The pace scenario (HOT, :47¹ half-mile projection) directly benefits tactical, late-closing performers; early-speed horses She's Country and Cosmic Candy Girl face deceleration vulnerability. Mommy's Turn, despite morning line favoritism at 5/2, projects as a significant bounce/regression candidate — third start off layoff following high-effort stakes win just 3 weeks prior. The public morning line is severely overvaluing this mare (28.6% implied probability vs. 19% model probability). This race presents elite value opportunity in All of It combined with high-confidence fade on the morning-line favorite. The model's primary value edge exists in backing the form horse (All of It's two consecutive turf route wins) over the regressing favorite (Mommy's Turn) at legitimate overlay odds.

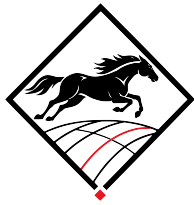
