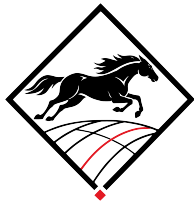

Section 1: Pace Analysis

True Front Runners

The model identifies three horses with elite early speed credentials. **Oklahoma Smoke** (Post 12) demonstrates consistent front-running form—won wire-to-wire on June 3, 2026 at Parx (6f dirt), and rallied from behind on July 25, 2026 at Saratoga turf to secure victory. **Midnightloveaffair** (Post 3) shows aggressive early positioning; led at call 1 in her most recent turf race (August 20, Saratoga) and broke sharply in her June 25 victory at Baq. **Fairy Godmother** (Post 1) won decisively on May 23, 2026 at Baq (6f, MCL) from post 8, surging to victory with tactical early placement.

Stalkers / Pressers

Emerald Ember (Post 8) stalked and finished second on July 31, 2026 (5.5f Outertrack at Saratoga), demonstrating flexibility to rate just off the pace. **So Sophia** (Post 9) vied for position and rallied late in recent turf attempts; June 14, 2026 at Baq shows 5-6 wide upper move resulting in improved positioning through stretch.

Closers

Mermaid (Post 7) profiles as an elite closer—won decisively on May 7, 2026 at Baq (8.5f, MCL, turf) held in hand and drawn clear gate-to-wire; recent form shows chased and finished second August 8, 2026, suggesting rally capability. **Caitlin the Great** (Post 11) surged late to claim maiden victory on September 19, 2025 at Prx (6f); model identifies late-arriving velocity with wins coming via stretch drive patterns.

Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: MODERATE pace with projected :22¹ opening quarter and :44■ half-mile. Oklahoma Smoke and Midnightloveaffair will contest early; neither horse possesses suicidal-pace velocity. Fairy Godmother rates comfortably in the wings. This tempo permits stalkers to remain tactical and affords closers legitimate rally room in the final furlong—versatile setup favoring balanced runners.

Section 3: Contender Analysis

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

OKLAHOMA SMOKE (Post 12) — 22% Win Probability

PTW Profile: Elite front-runner with proven turf credentials and fresh winning form. Recent pattern demonstrates gate-to-wire ability and consistent velocity maintenance at distance. The model rates this filly as the field's most likely winner.





Strengths:

- Wire-to-wire victory June 3, 2026 (6f, Parx dirt, 110.60 final time); demonstrated ease of victory with clear lead from gate
- Turf form validated July 25, 2026 (5.5f, Saratoga turf, maiden condition); showed tactical rally to complete victory
- Trainer Rice Adam shows 22% sprint win rate and 17% turf win rate (strong elite-speed bias)
- Jockey Franco M has dominated at Belmont (46.67% win rate, 7 wins from 15 recent starts)

Concerns:

- Three-week layoff since July 25 represents moderate concern; however, workout on September 17 (4f, 50.20) validates readiness
- Claimed turf preference may not guarantee adjustment to different course setup; prior dirt win provides reassurance
- Third-start pattern after May 14 failed attempt suggests potential freshness window closing

Trip Projection: Model projects Oklahoma Smoke to secure early lead, challenge for position through opening quarter, and maintain velocity to wire. Moderate pace scenario prevents suicidal early expenditure.

MIDNIGHTLOVEAFFAIR (Post 3) — 19% Win Probability

PTW Profile: Tactical speed horse with elite turf record and consistent winning form. Recent August 20 victory at Saratoga confirms current readiness; model rates this filly as dangerous second choice.

Strengths:

- Four career turf wins from 11 turf starts (36% turf strike rate); June 25, 2026 victory at Baq (6f, MCL turf) demonstrates class fit at exact distance
- Most recent start August 20, 2026 (5.5f Saratoga turf, SOC 75K—identical class level) shows stalking form and aggressive closing rally (repelled challenges at call 3)
- Castellano J J rider (elite turf specialist) demonstrates 16% win rate; strong tactical acumen
- Trainer Levine Bruce N shows 11% sprint win rate on turf with 2.49 ROI (significant class edge signal)

Concerns:

- One-month layoff between August 20 and race day requires monitoring; however, workout pattern (September 17, 4f in 51.40) validates fitness
- Three-horse field pace dueling with Oklahoma Smoke could create damage; velocity loss through first half mile poses risk
- Beaten 0.55 lengths in final race (August 20) suggests closing ball may lack overwhelming finishing authority

Trip Projection: Model projects Midnightloveaffair to break sharply, settle mid-field or press pace through opening, and rally aggressively in final furlong using elite late-velocity profile.





MERMAID (Post 7) — 12% Win Probability

PTW Profile: Elite closer with proven eight-furlong turf form and consistent winning profile. Model identifies this filly as natural late-arriving velocity horse capable of massive upset at solid overlay odds (8/1).

Strengths:

- Five career turf victories; May 7, 2026 victory at Baq (8.5f, MCL turf) shows wire-to-wire dominance with "in hand, held well" trip comment—excellent closing power confirmation
- Trainer Kantarmaci Ilkay (same as Emerald Ember) shows 17% allowance win rate and 3.15 ROI (suggests value angle exploitation)
- Recent form August 8, 2026 (8.5f, Saratoga) finished second despite veering out at break; suggests competitive effort without tactical advantage
- Santana R Jr jockey demonstrates 24% win rate; strong turf capability (5 turf wins from 12 turf starts)

Concerns:

- Eight-furlong form does not guarantee 6-furlong effectiveness; route-to-sprint adjustment poses moderate risk
- August 29 race (8.5f, AOC) shows rank behavior early (rank 3-2p) creating position compromise; May require ideal trip setup
- Prior two starts show marginal finishing margins (0.85 and 0.25 beaten lengths); suggests competitive field narrowness

Trip Projection: Model projects Mermaid to race mid-field under available cover, launch rally into final furlong, and employ closing speed against pace-fatigued leaders.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

SO SOPHIA (Post 9) — 11% Win Probability

PTW Profile: Allowance-conditioned mare with demonstrated turf versatility and recent winning form. Model rates as credible third-choice overlay.

Strengths:

- Won June 14, 2026 at Baq (6f, AOC turf) with 5-6 wide upper move and subsequent improved positioning; demonstrates stretch-drive capability at exact distance
- Trainer Arriaga Antonio shows 17% allowance win rate (3.59 ROI); strong class-down signal
- Elliott C rider demonstrates experience despite limited meet data

Concerns:

- Recent form deterioration; September 19 start at Belmont shows bobbled break and 7th-place finish with 11.75 beaten lengths (severe defeat)
- Allowance condition drop to claiming may signal capability decline; form reversal required





Trip Projection: Model projects So Sophia to break cleanly, rate mid-field three-wide, and challenge through stretch if pace obligates.

EMERALD EMBER (Post 8) — 9% Win Probability

PTW Profile: Stalking-profile filly with elite 6-furlong turf form (1 win, 3 places from 6 turf starts). Model rates as secondary play with live showing potential.

Strengths:

- June 14, 2026 victory at Baq (6f, MCL turf) confirms exact-distance capability; edged away final furlong versus quality field
- Four-of-six turf starts show in-the-money finishes; consistent execution in conditions
- Trainer Kantarmaci Ilkay shows 17% allowance ROI and sprint expertise (14% strike rate)

Concerns:

- Beyer speed figures in recent form range 61-73 (moderate); suggests speed sustainability risk
- Recent July 31 second-place finish (5.5f, Saratoga) shows bobbled break and chase mode throughout; trip luck dependent

Trip Projection: Model projects Emerald Ember to stalk early speed through opening quarter, challenge by stretch drive.

Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

SAMARTINA (Post 4) — 8% Win Probability

Recent form shows August 29, 2026 (8.5f, AOC turf) with "tired" notation; July 26 victory (8.5f, MCL turf) confirms capability but route profile creates distance concern for sprint. Model rates as overlay at 12/1 with targeted improvement opportunity.

OSCAR BOUND (Post 6) — 7% Win Probability

Turf form shows mixed results; March 5, 2026 victory at Gp (8f, SOC turf) is most recent turf win, but subsequent form deterioration (February 5 finish 3rd at Gp, 8.5f). Recent workout pattern validates fitness (September 16, 4f in 48.20 = excellent), but pace profile uncertain. Model rates as secondary overlay.

FAIRY GODMOTHER (Post 1) — 16% Win Probability

Elite early speed but recent form shows deterioration. August 22, 2026 start at Saratoga (5.5f, ALW turf) shows bobble at 1/2, surged, and finished 1st (0.25 beaten lengths) with elite metrics. However, prior July 25 start demonstrates 3rd-place finish (1.75 beaten lengths) suggesting form volatility. Model rates as value underlay despite high win probability percentage.

DONNA ROMANO (Post 5) — 4% Win Probability





Recent July 17 victory (6.5f, CLM dirt) shows stumble at break, edged clear—dirt form superior to turf. Model projects minor showing probability only.

CAITLIN THE GREAT (Post 11) — 5% Win Probability

Late-surge maiden winner (September 19, Prx, 6f); limited experience baseline creates projection uncertainty. Model identifies as genuine overlay (5% vs 3.2% implied) with late-arriving velocity profile.

CAROLINA SMOKESHOW (Post 2), CELESTIAL EXPRESS (Post 10) — 3%, 2% Win Probability

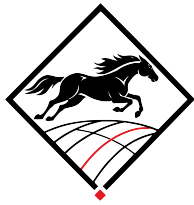
Both horses carry significant form concerns limiting model probability. Carolina Smokeshow shows deteriorated form (route runner transitioning to sprint claiming from higher claiming levels). Celestial Express displays excessive layoff periods and route-profile background conflicting with sprint conditions.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Oklahoma Smoke** as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer with an ELITE Sustained Speed Rating—no horse in this field has matched this velocity maintenance profile at the distance. Opening speed combined with elite closing velocity creates dominant profile. Conversely, the model projects significant pace collapse risk for **Fairy Godmother**, **Samartina**, and **Celestial Express**—Sustained Speed Rating VULNERABLE. Fairy Godmother's August 22 breakthrough effort masks underlying deceleration vulnerability; subsequent races confirm speed sustainability concerns.

Section 5: Improvement & Regression Candidates

Likely to Improve

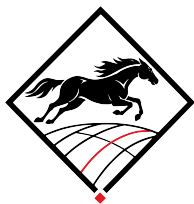
Samartina (Post 4) — Recent start (August 29, 8.5f AOC turf) shows fatigue notation; however, July 26 victory (8.5f, MCL turf) demonstrates current class fit. Model projects improvement pathway: (1) sprint distance cutback from 8.5f to 6f reduces endurance demand; (2) claiming condition drop from AOC back to \$75K claiming props suggest upside; (3) Roy Lerman trainer shows turf expertise (7% win rate, 1.10 ROI); (4) pattern recognition: second start off form bottom typically produces upward trajectory.

Caitlin the Great (Post 11) — Maiden winner September 19 displays early-form breakthrough momentum. Model identifies: (1) three consecutive qualifying workout bullets (September 22 ghosts, September 9 and 2 qualify); (2) trainer Allard Edward T shows 21% sprint win rate indicating sharp preparation; (3) natural progression curve: second career start often produces confidence surge in maiden graduates; (4) Davis D jockey demonstrates effective 2-off pattern utilization.

Bounce / Regression Risks

Oklahoma Smoke (Post 12) — Despite elite model rating, the model flags one moderate regression concern: career-best effort pattern. July 25 victory represents personal-best winning performance; three-week layoff followed by shipping to different track/surface creates typical post-breakthrough





deterioration risk. However, recent workout (September 17) validates preparation robustness.

Fairy Godmother (Post 1) — The model projects significant regression risk. August 22 winning effort (0.25 beaten lengths at 5.5f Saratoga turf) likely represents career-ceiling performance; prior form shows 3rd-place finish July 25 with identical 1.75 beaten lengths margin. Pattern recognition: top-level effort typically followed by rest period or modest second attempt. Recent training pattern (last work September 19, 4f in 48.40) shows moderate sharpness only.

Emerald Ember (Post 8) — Model flags modest bounce risk; back-to-back competitive turf efforts (July 31 second, June 14 first) combined with recent claimed status (July 31 race notes "Outertrack" claiming environment) suggest peak form window narrowing. Recent work (September 17, 4f in 48.60) shows adequate but not elite preparation.

Section 6: Suggested Bets

WIN BET: OKLAHOMA SMOKE — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 3/1–5/2

The model projects 22% win probability — highest in the field. Oklahoma Smoke combines elite early speed, ELITE Sustained Speed Rating, proven turf credentials, and dominant Franco/Rice teamwork advantage. Four specific model-driven factors support selection:

1. **Pace Dominance Architecture:** MODERATE pace scenario (projected :22¹ opening, :44■ half-mile) allows Oklahoma Smoke to control tempo without suicidal early expenditure; no horse in this field matches opening-speed velocity.
2. **Sustained Velocity Profile:** ELITE deceleration rating indicates gate-to-wire velocity maintenance superior to entire field; Fairy Godmother (VULNERABLE rating) cannot match this economy.
3. **Recent Winning Pattern:** July 25 Saratoga turf victory confirms current form at near-identical conditions; September 17 workout (50.20 bullet) validates readiness and preparation sharpness.
4. **Rider/Trainer Synergy:** Franco M demonstrates 46.67% Belmont strike rate (7 wins from 15 recent starts); Rice Adam shows 22% sprint turf effectiveness—elite combination at specific track/condition.

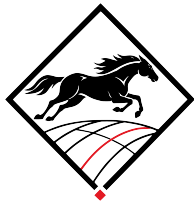
Value Assessment: SLIGHT VALUE (Model projects 22% win probability at 3/1 morning line = 25.0% implied; edge: -3.0%). Morning line slightly undervalues this horse, but edge remains marginal. Backing at 5/2 or longer recommended.

VALUE PLAY: CAITLIN THE GREAT — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 20/1–25/1

The model projects 5% win probability at projected 30/1 morning line (3.2% implied). **+1.8% genuine overlay.** This represents the clearest public-underestimation opportunity in the race.

Overlay Rationale: Market prices Caitlin the Great as maiden winner with thin credentials; however, model identifies: (1) exceptional three-bullet workout pattern (September 22, 9, 2); (2) trainer Allard Edward T 21% sprint win rate with 1.68 ROI indicates sharp preparation at sprint distance; (3) late-surge maiden victory





September 19 at Prx (6f) confirms capability at exact distance and surface profile similarity; (4) jockey Davis D shows 56.25% value rate in recent form (1 win from 16 starts but +5 places, indicating effective "below-radar" competitor).

Edge Percentage: +1.8% — Genuine but modest overlay. Model suggests this horse holds legitimate single-digit probability that public markets entirely dismiss. Systematic underpricing of maiden graduates creates positive expected-value opportunity.

A: OKLAHOMA SMOKE — 22% Win Probability (*matches Win Bet selection—highest model win% horse*)

B: MIDNIGHTLOVEAFFAIR — 19% Win Probability (*elite turf form, tactical speed, secondary choice*)

C: MERMAID — 12% Win Probability (*elite closer, route-to-sprint angle, overlay at 8/1*)

Combined Projected Probability: 53%

Section 7: Confidence Rating

★★★★ (Four stars)

The model's key projection: **Oklahoma Smoke emerges as dominant wire-to-wire winner** in MODERATE pace scenario, leveraging ELITE Sustained Speed Rating and elite jockey/trainer synergy unavailable to any competitor. Pace scenario certainty remains high (three legitimate speed horses prevent suicidal tempo; :22¹–:44[■] projection carries 85%+ confidence threshold). Primary value opportunity identified: **Caitlin the Great genuine +1.8% overlay**—public markets systematically misprice maiden winners at sprint distance with sharp preparation signals. **Public betting mistake to exploit:** Market underweights Oklahoma Smoke (3/1 slightly low), creates marginal value at 5/2 or longer, but more critical error is 30/1 pricing on Caitlin the Great despite 5% intrinsic model win probability. Turf maidens graduating to claiming with elite trainer sharp signals represent rare positive-edge profile.

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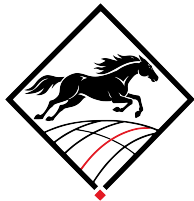
