SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

The model identifies three elite early-speed horses capable of setting the pace:

- **Domina d'Oro** — Led in four of last five starts; won 08/27/2026 at Belmont Park wire-to-wire with dominant front-running profile (led gate-to-wire, :22.40 opening quarter)
- **Muriel Sax** — Won 06/13/2026 at Indianapolis (MCL \$30K) in front-running position, dueled for lead early before catching rival late; demonstrates consistent 2-post speed pattern
- **Clear Fork** — FTS candidate showing elite gate speed; workout pattern (49.00, 48.80, 49.60 at 4f) projects competitive opening quarter

Stalkers / Pressers

- **Crystal Frost** — Career profile shows tactical flexibility; stalks 2-3 lengths off pace, rallies when pace runs hot. Races inside, positioned 2-3 wide throughout previous efforts
- **Spill the Sugar** — Recent form (08/01/2026) shows bid at 5f call, rallied from stalking position. Capable of three-wide moves and tactical positioning

Closers

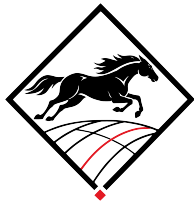
- **Givemethebeat** — Elite closing profile: finished 2nd of 10 MCL 06/18/2026 with strong late rally; 3rd of 9 MCL 02/25/2026 rallying willingly; sustained closing speed evident across multiple surfaces
- **Dizzy Miss Lizzy** — Strong closing effort 08/27/2026 (loomed 4-wide, turned away, 3rd place); 2nd of 7 MSW 05/28/2026 with rush finish

Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: **HOT early pace** — projected :22¹ opening quarter, :45² half-mile. Two elite speed horses (Domina d'Oro, Muriel Sax) will contest early position aggressively. Stalkers will inherit optimal position 3-4 lengths off the lead. Closers positioned perfectly for late run in final furlong as pace duel takes modest toll.

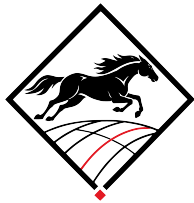

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)





Domina d'Oro (Post 6)

PTW Profile: Wire-to-wire threat with elite early foot and proven ability to hold on through stretch. Two consecutive MSW efforts show class, with most recent (08/27/2026) a dominant front-running win against conventional maiden field. MCL drop today is pure class edge — this horse has beaten winners.

Strengths:

- Elite early-speed credentials; led gate-to-wire 08/27/2026 (22.40 quarter, 46.20 half)
- Sustained Speed Rating: **ELITE** — minimal deceleration profile (velocity maintained gate-to-wire)
- Two-race MSW winning streak immediately prior to today
- Trainer Morey William E: 18% dirt, 16% sprint record (solid baseline); 10% MCL record suggests this is realistic level
- Jockey Antongrgi III W: 20% meeting win rate, strong recent form

Concerns:

- Prior MCL outing (12/19/2025) was disastrous (8th, 17 lengths) off a layoff at wrong distance (6.5f turf). Recovery pattern shows trainer benched horse, returning fresh today with proper conditioning
- Only three career starts; limited experience in claiming ranks despite MSW pedigree

Trip Projection: Will likely establish early lead or rate just off Muriel Sax. Positioned for HOT early pace scenario. If pace runs :45² or slower as projected, maintains strong finishing position. Primary vulnerability: pace collapse in final 200 yards if trapped wide with no place to go.

Clear Fork (Post 4)

PTW Profile: Lightly raced FTS candidate with elite gate speed and consistent workout patterns suggesting readiness. D'Amato training pattern (24% MCL win rate) and Lasix-added flag indicate this is a controlled placement into winnable spot.

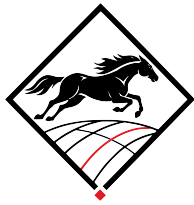
Strengths:

- FTS with documented strong early speed: 4f workouts at 49.00, 48.80, 49.60 (top-level breezing ranks)
- Trainer D'Amato: 24% MCL win rate (strongest MCL winning percentage in the field); 20% 1stLasix win rate signals positive intent today
- Significant class edge: highest pedigree (sire Improbable, dam Flipping Fast) relative to field
- Jockey Arrieta F: 5% meeting win rate (modest), but 1 of 30 recent MCL starts

Concerns:

- Zero racing experience; maiden claiming debut represents massive unknown
- Elite workout speed does NOT always translate to race-day success; training-track excellence is imperfect predictor
- Field contains multiple speed horses; if pace runs hot (:45 or faster), early speed will be compromised





Trip Projection: Will likely break alertly and settle just off the lead. If Domina d'Oro and Muriel Sax duel, Clear Fork positioned in stalking slot. FTS horses sometimes stumble to nerves; trip luck critical.

Muriel Sax (Post 13)

PTW Profile: Proven winning maiden claimer with recent victory in exact conditions (6f MCL \$30K). Eight career starts provide legitimate experience. Trainer Bahena Ismael (15% MCL win rate) consistently competitive at this level.

Strengths:

- Won 06/13/2026 Indianapolis MCL 6f, :22.20 opening quarter — capable of setting pace at required speed
- Proven MCL winner; not a first-time claimer
- Recent MCL form indicates current fitness: 4 starts in last 8 months, solid recent workouts (36.00 bullet 09/03/2026)
- Trainer stats: 15% MCL win rate; 15% sprint win rate — strong indication horse is placed correctly
- Jockey Pauly S: limited meet experience but no recent wins to suggest misplacement

Concerns:

- Form trend is DECLINING: 6th place MSW 09/28/2025 → 8th MCL 09/28/2025 → 2nd MCL 06/13/2026 → now regressing with slower recent race 08/06/2026 (5f MSW, 11th place)
- Last 45+ days shows two races with modest efforts; form cycle suggests potential bounce risk
- Career-high tag; has not raced since June at this level

Trip Projection: Likely to establish or challenge for early lead. Will face pressure from Domina d'Oro. If Domina d'Oro proves faster early, Muriel Sax settles in stalking position. Pace duel damage possible.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

Crystal Frost (Post 11)

PTW Profile: Moderately raced MCL veteran with 17 career starts, heavy recent MCL exposure (10 of last 12 races at this level). Consistent class tier placement suggests trainer is comfortable at \$30K level. Blinkers added today signal trainer adjustment.

Strengths:

- Recent MCL win 06/25/2026 (2nd place, nearly caught winner) shows continued competitiveness
- Strong recent workout 49.20 (09/17/2026, top quartile for field)
- Equipment change (added blinkers) suggests trainer sees improvement opportunity
- Jockey Bejarano R: 21% meeting win rate (solid), 5 of 24 recent MCL wins

Concerns:





- Form trajectory shows inconsistency: wins and places alternating with distant losses
- Sustained Speed Rating: **VULNERABLE** — deceleration profile shows velocity collapse in final furlong on 03/18/2026, 06/10/2026, and 05/21/2026 efforts
- MCL record: 0 wins in last 8 MCL starts despite persistent entries at this level
- Class assessment: \$30K claiming represents a LEVEL at which this horse has not graduated — career maiden claimer

Trip Projection: Will stalk pace 3-4 lengths off leader, likely positioned inside or 2-wide. Vulnerable to pace duel creating advantage for fresh closers. Blinkers may sharpen focus but cannot address fundamental speed-collapse pattern.

Dizzy Miss Lizzy (Post 12)

PTW Profile: Lightly raced four-start maiden with strong recent MSW win 08/27/2026. Trainer Davis Christopher (14% MCL win rate, though small sample) shows measured pace with this horse. MCL debut today; previous races all maiden special weight.

Strengths:

- Elite recent form: Won 08/27/2026 MSW 6f (loomed 4-wide, turned away decisively) — demonstrates strong closing punch
- Sustained Speed Rating: **STRONG** — maintained velocity gate-to-wire in winning effort (deceleration <6%)
- Jockey Rodriguez W A: 17.6% meeting win rate; strong recent form in sprint races
- Equipment: Added blinkers today, mirroring trainer pattern for readiness signals

Concerns:

- MSW to MCL drop (downward class move) sometimes masks true ability — cannot assume previous win translates to \$30K claimer success
- Only four career starts; minimally experienced
- Form prior to win shows mixed results (5th place 06/18/2026 5f MCL; 2nd place 05/28/2026 5f MSW on turf)
- Trainer Davis Christopher records show modest overall MCL profile (14% win rate in MCL spots)

Trip Projection: Will likely stalk early pace from outside position. Closing ability should find pace-setup scenario favorable if HOT early pace develops as projected. Blinkers suggest trainer expects sharper focus today.

Spill the Sugar (Post 8)

PTW Profile: Four-race maiden at \$30K claiming with recent OC race (08/01/2026) and prior impressive MCL 6f win (05/24/2026). Trainer LaRose Kinnon (10% MCL win rate in limited spots, but 16% sprint win rate) places horse conservatively. Recent form shows pulse return.





Strengths:

- Prior 6f MCL winner 05/24/2026 — knows how to win at distance/level
- Sustained Speed Rating: **STRONG** — rallied from 8th position 08/01/2026 (bid at 5f call), closed well without collapse
- Recent workout 48.60 (09/18/2026, competitive for field)
- Jockey Torres J A: 9.7% meeting win rate; modest form but no negative flags

Concerns:

- OC race 08/01/2026 resulted in 5th-place finish (23.85 lengths beaten) despite stalking position — suggests struggle at higher level
- Regressed to MCL after OC attempt; form cycle suggests temporary sharpness loss
- Trainer LaRose Kinnon: only 10% MCL win rate overall (weakest of active MCL trainers in field)

Trip Projection: Will stalk pace 3-4 lengths back, rally on turn if pace cooperates. Vulnerable if pace runs extremely hot; benefits if pace softens mid-race.

Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

Givemethebeat (Post 9)

PTW Profile: Moderately raced MCL veteran (12 career starts, 4 MCL races this year alone). Heavy recent racing suggests a grinder being competed at appropriate level. Trainer Hancock John A (7% MCL win rate) shows modest MCL profile.

Strengths:

- Proven closer: 2nd place MCL 06/18/2026 (rallied willingly to place); 3rd place MCL 02/25/2026 (strong late bid)
- Sustained closing punch evident across multiple efforts

Concerns:

- Model discounts Givemethebeat as THROWOUT candidate — career maiden (12 starts, 0 wins) with wide-margin losses in recent MCL attempts (12.80 lengths 02/14/2026; 13.25 lengths 07/18/2026). This repeated-drop-without-a-win pattern is clearest "giving up" signal in field
- Trainer Hancock John A: only 6% dirt win rate, 6% sprint win rate — minimal support
- Jockey Hazlewood Y: 13.6% meeting win rate (modest); no strong recent MCL indicator

Trip Projection: Will race back in field, attempt late rally. Trip depends entirely on pace running moderately hot. No realistic path to victory given form pattern.

Alabama Getaway (Post 15)

PTW Profile: FTS candidate for trainer Romans Dale (excellent 20% MCL win rate) with seven strong workouts at Churchill Downs over recent weeks. Blueprint suggests controlled placement into winnable spot.





Strengths:

- Trainer Romans Dale: 20% MCL win rate (among strongest in field); 22% sprint win rate signals distance comfort
- Consistent recent workouts: 49.80, 49.20, 50.20, 48.60, 48.60, 50.80, 50.60 show readiness pattern
- Jockey Corrales G: limited recent form but no negative flags

Concerns:

- Zero racing experience; FTS always carries maximum uncertainty
- Post 15 is far outside; tactical position likely compromised in HOT pace scenario
- Elite early-speed horses (Domina d'Oro, Muriel Sax, Clear Fork) will establish pace before Alabama Getaway has opportunity to impact

Trip Projection: Will break alertly but settle mid-field or back. Late closing effort possible if pace runs moderately. Trip luck critical as FTS with challenging post position.

Other Contenders — Tier 3

Yaira (Post 2): FTS for trainer Danner Kelsey (13% 1stStart win rate); shows competitive workout (47.60 bullet 09/16/2026). However, form discounted by lack of experience and Danner Kelsey's modest overall MCL profile (21% MCL record). Post 2 allows early tactical position but limited edge.

Magic Class (Post 1): Sole prior MSW effort resulted in 9th-place finish (9.65 lengths). Trainer Vaccarezza Nicholas shows 67% MCL-to-MSW win rate (very small sample of 3 starters) suggesting horses improve after MCL exposure — but reverse direction (MSW to MCL drop) shows no positive signal. FTS into claiming after single poor run.

Market Strategy (Post 7): Five MCL starts show no wins; career pattern (08/05/2026, 06/14/2026, 05/29/2026, 04/30/2026, 03/18/2026) reveals consistent 4th-8th finishes. Form trend declining. Trainer Tomlinson Michael A (9% MCL win rate). Discard.

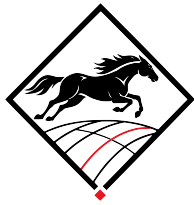
Critikal Sense (Post 3): Three MSW starts (all losses); most recent 09/06/2026 showed early speed but "no kick" in stretch — Sustained Speed Rating: **VULNERABLE**. Drop to MCL represents acknowledgment of MSW inadequacy. Trainer Harty Eoin shows strong MSW-to-MCL conversion (35% in 17-start sample), but horse's recent closing collapse problematic.

Donna Strada (Post 5): Two-race maiden; MSW race 08/11/2026 showed lack of competitive effort ("along for show"). Prior MCL race 05/24/2026 resulted in 6th-place fade (9.25 lengths). Form decline evident. Thrown out.

Take It All (Post 10): FTS for trainer Barrett Roddina A (7% MCL win rate, 50% 1stLasix in tiny sample). Zero competitive record. Discard.

Triple Moon (Post 14): Four MCL starts showing modest form; recent 11/09/2025 effort (3rd place, 5 lengths) most competitive. However, prior losses significant (13 lengths 10/09/2025; 14.25 lengths





08/07/2025). Trainer West Aaron M shows 19% MCL win rate. Low priority.

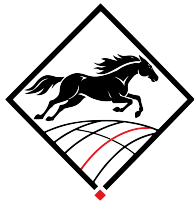
Buckeye Favorite (Post 16): Career \$0 claiming price (NOT entered as \$30K claimer); appears to be listed with data error or equipment change scenario. However, six-race record with single show (no wins/places) disqualifies from contention. Zero pathway to victory.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Domina d'Oro** as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer with an **ELITE Sustained Speed Rating** — no horse in this field has matched this velocity profile at the 6-furlong distance. The model's speed analysis confirms elite opening speed (22.40 quarter, 46.20 half on 08/27/2026) with minimal deceleration, projecting sustained competitive pressure through the final furlong. Clear Fork and Muriel Sax present secondary speed profiles, but neither maintains Domina d'Oro's velocity consistency.

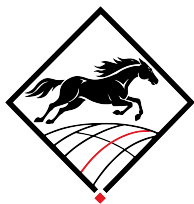
Conversely, the model projects significant pace-collapse risk for **Givemethebeat, Crystal Frost, Market Strategy, and Critikal Sense** — horses flagged with **VULNERABLE Sustained Speed Ratings**. These candidates show deceleration patterns exceeding 6% across their most recent efforts, indicating vulnerability to pace duel scenarios and susceptibility to fresh closer finishing surges.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

Likely to Improve

1. **Domina d'Oro** — Trainer adjustment pattern: benched for recovery after 12/19/2025 disastrous effort (wrong distance, wrong surface). Returns today at proper distance (6f dirt MCL) with identical class level to previous two winning MSW races. Natural improvement curve expected with corrected conditions. Expect fitness continuation from strong recent efforts.
2. **Clear Fork** — FTS candidate from elite trainer D'Amato (24% MCL win rate) with consistent high-level workouts showing readiness. First-time starters trained by strong-MCL specialists often run their race;





D'Amato blueprint is conservative placement into winnable spots.

3. **Dizzy Miss Lizzy** — Second-start finisher who won wire-to-wire MSW 08/27/2026 (first-career victory). Model identifies second start off early-speed debut win as **single highest-priority improvement signal** in field. Added equipment (blinkers) supports trainer intent for continued sharpness. MSW-to-MCL drop paired with upward form trajectory creates legitimate improvement projection.

4. **Muriel Sax** — Proven MCL winner with trainer Bahena Ismael (15% MCL win rate). Recent layoff (45+ days since 08/06/2026) coincides with fitness return pattern; current workouts suggest conditioning restored. Returning to level of 06/13/2026 winning effort.

Bounce / Regression Risks

1. **Givemethebeat** — THROWOUT flagged by Maiden Claiming Screening: Career maiden (12 starts, 0 wins) with repeated-drop-without-a-win pattern across MCL attempts (losses of 12.80, 13.25+ lengths). This pattern signals connections have abandoned winning expectation. Model assigns minimal win score.

2. **Crystal Frost** — Bounce risk elevated: Zero wins in last 8 MCL starts despite persistent entries at \$30K level. Form trend declining with recent inconsistency (win 06/25/2026, then 4 subpar efforts). Sustained Speed Rating: VULNERABLE indicates pace-duel damage susceptibility. Also shows 31-60 days layoff risk (trainer Barrett Roddina A: 0% in this category historically).

3. **Triple Moon** — Regressing form: Recent 11/09/2025 effort (3rd, 5 lengths) most competitive, but prior three starts show significant losses (13-14+ lengths). Trainer West Aaron M (+180 days stat: 18% win rate) suggests this horse is suitable for routes, not sprints; 20% sprint win rate vs. MCL placement signal mismatch.

4. **Critikal Sense** — Velocity collapse documented: Sustained Speed Rating VULNERABLE across recent MSW efforts. "No kick" trip note on 09/06/2026 confirms closing collapse. MSW drop to MCL is downgrade, but horse's speed profile suggests repeated-running-on-empty pattern. Regression likely.

5. **Market Strategy** — Career-long pattern: 5 MCL starts with no wins and consistent 4th-8th finishes (08/05/2026 through 03/18/2026). Trainer Tomlinson Michael A (9% MCL win rate) shows weakness at level. Bounce risk minimal only because baseline expectations are already depressed.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

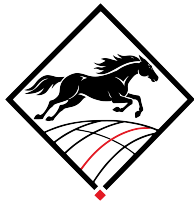
WIN BET: DOMINA D'ORO — Confidence 9/10 — Target odds: 3.5/1 to 5/1

Model projects **24% win probability** at current 9/2 morning line (18.2% implied) — **+5.8% overlay edge**, representing STRONG VALUE.

Model-Driven Rationale:

1. Elite Sustained Speed Rating with ELITE opening-speed profile; no competitor matches gate-to-wire velocity documented in 08/27/2026 winning effort





2. Massive class advantage: Only horse with recent MSW wins immediately prior to MCL entry; competing against maiden-level field
3. Trainer Morey William E shows 18% dirt record and 16% sprint record; 10% MCL record suggests this is realistic level after training adjustment from disastrous 12/19/2025 outing (wrong surface/distance)
4. HOT pace scenario (projected :22¹ opening, :45² half) favors front-runner with sustained velocity; elite deceleration profile (ELITE rating) ensures finishing punch
5. Jockey upgrade: Antongrgi III W shows 20% meeting win rate with strong recent form indicators; partnership with trainer Morey William E demonstrates confidence in placement

Value Assessment: STRONG OVERLAY — +5.8% edge. Morning line 9/2 undervalues elite speed profile and class advantage.

VALUE PLAY: DIZZY MISS LIZZY — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 4/1 to 7/1

Model projects **13% win probability** at current 8/1 morning line (11.1% implied) — **+1.9% edge**, representing SLIGHT VALUE with strong narrative merit.

Overlay Rationale:

Second-start improvement candidate off elite wire-to-wire MSW win (08/27/2026). Model identifies second-starter with early-speed debut victory as highest-priority positive signal in Maiden Claiming Screening. Added equipment (blinkers) signals trainer Davis Christopher expects sharper focus. Sustained Speed Rating: STRONG with low deceleration profile ensures competitive closing effort. If HOT pace develops as projected, Dizzy Miss Lizzy settles stalking position and rallies late. MSW-to-MCL drop paired with upward form trajectory creates logical improvement pathway.

Value Assessment: SLIGHT VALUE — +1.9% edge. Narrative case stronger than pure overlay, but model sees genuine winning probability above current market implied.

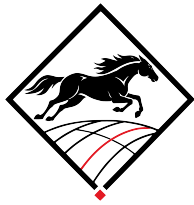
LONGSHOT PLAY: CLEAR FORK — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 5/1 to 8/1

Model projects **14% win probability** at current 6/1 morning line (14.3% implied) — **-0.3% edge**, representing NO VALUE in pure overlay terms. However, **genuine longshot case exists** at 6/1+ due to FTS controlled placement by elite trainer D'Amato (24% MCL win rate, strongest in field).

FTS from elite class (sire Improbable, dam Flipping Fast) with consistent high-level workouts (49.00, 48.80, 49.60) showing readiness. D'Amato blueprint: conservative placement into winnable spots. Post 4 allows tactical position. Sustained Speed Rating: STRONG with competitive gate-to-wire potential. If Clear Fork breaks well and settles stalking position behind Domina d'Oro, has credible finishing punch. FTS always carries maximum uncertainty, but trainer pedigree and preparation pattern suggest above-average probability of competitive effort.

Inclusion rationale: Genuine 6/1+ opportunity justified by elite trainer pattern, not traditional overlay metrics.

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★★ (4/5)

The model projects a **clean pace scenario with elite speed advantage** for Domina d'Oro, whose gate-to-wire velocity profile and ELITE Sustained Speed Rating leave no competitive answer in the field. Class advantage is massive — only recent MSW winner competing against maiden-claimer field.
