SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

Nightmare Fuel (Post 5) — Elite early speed profile. Led wire-to-wire at this level on 06/12/2026 (CLM 30000, 7f), establishing herself as a natural speed horse. Most recently (08/16/2026), pressed early from post 2 at EIP (6.5f STR), challenged at the three-sixteenths pole before fading. Tactical flexibility evident; proven ability to dictate pace at the claiming level. Opening quarter tendencies: :22 range consistently.

No Time Left (Post 3) — Versatile pacing profile with front-running capability. Won at this distance (6f CLM) on 08/15/2026 from post 3, chasing the early pace then taking over in the stretch (:22.2 opening quarter, :45.8 half). Multiple wire-to-wire victories at MCL and CLM levels establish her as a legitimate speed threat today.

Poppy Woppy (Post 6) — Secondary speed presence. Broke poorly from post 3 on 07/10/2026 (6f CLM, my) but recovered to challenge inside the final quarter (:22.2 opening, :45.4 half). Recent work (09/17/2026, 4f, :47.4, ranked 2nd of 20 at EIP) signals sharpness entering this race.

Stalkers / Pressers

Tizianna (Post 4) — Rating-style speed horse with stretch-run punch. Most recent outing (09/10/2026, 6f CLM, gd) shows steady advance four-wide, moving from 4th at the quarter to 3rd at finish (:22.6 opening, :46.0 half). Prefers to stalk early pressure and rally into contention.

Nut Bush City (Post 2) — Recently claimed; lightly raced in claiming ranks. Two MSW wins early career (04/23/2026, 06/06 pattern), moved up to AOC then ALW with moderate success. Latest claiming race (06/24/2026, 6.5f AOC, fst) shows trailing position but no factor. Blinkers on today — signature equipment addition by trainer Calhoun. Strong 31-60 day window trainer stat: 17% wins at 1.49 ROI.

Closers

Transatlantic (Post 1) — Closing profile with late-race punch. Most recent race (08/17/2026, 8f CLM my, EIP) shows tactical race from 3rd at Call1 (beaten 1.1L) to 2nd at finish (5.6L beaten). Prior MCL win (07/04/2025, 6f, 1.25 beaten lengths, :22.0 opening quarter) demonstrates finishing ability at distance. Layoff pattern (42 days) is within acceptable range; recent workouts consistent (:48.6–:49.4 range, mid-pack rankings).

MODEL PREDICTS: **HOT** early pace scenario with two elite speed horses (**Nightmare Fuel** and **No Time Left**) contesting the lead. Projected :22¹–:22² opening quarter, :45■–:45■ half-mile. Speed duel will generate moderate pace damage; pace-stalkers like **Tizianna** and fresh second-time claimers positioned to capitalize on fractional attrition.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

TIZIANNA (Post 4, 4/1 ML)

PTW Profile: Tizianna emerges as the model's top-rated contender in a HOT pace scenario. The model identifies her as ideally positioned to benefit from early pace friction between Nightmare Fuel and No Time Left. Her stalking profile and four-wide closing action translate perfectly into a race where speed horses will tax each other early. Class is consistent at the CLM 30000 level; recent form shows three races at this exact tag in the past 6 weeks.

Strengths:

- **Pace setup perfection:** Natural stalker in a two-speed duel scenario
- **Consistent claiming level:** Proven at CLM 30000; last six starts include three CLM races at current tag
- **Stretch acceleration:** 09/10/2026 finish demonstrates late-race burst from 4th to 3rd with steady four-wide advance





- **Distance proven:** Multiple 6f finishes with competitive placing; no distance concern
- **Equipment continuity:** Blinkers on today (consistent with 09/10/2026 recent win); soundness stable

Concerns:

- **Trainer form:** Helen Pitts shows 0% win pct in CLM (21 starts, 0 wins); York meet stats weak (3 starts, 0 wins)
- **Class plateau:** Career earnings modest; may have found her ceiling at this level
- **Recent jockey pairing:** Morales E only 9.76% wins at CD over last 30 days (below meet average)

Trip Projection: Tizianna will rate in 3rd or 4th early, allow Nightmare Fuel and No Time Left to duel ahead. As pace deteriorates at the half (:45■–:45■ range with two speed horses pressing), she'll advance four-wide into the stretch with clear running room and target the tiring leaders into the final furlong.

NO TIME LEFT (Post 3, 6/1 ML)

PTW Profile: The model projects No Time Left as the second-most dangerous horse in this field, delivering +9.7% overlay value at 6/1. She combines elite early speed—necessary for pace dominance today—with proven form at this exact distance and class level. Last three CLM races (08/15/2026, 06/26/2026, 06/06/2026) all at CLM 30000 confirm comfort with the tag. Her win on 08/15/2026 (6f CLM, fst, :22.2–:45.8) is a direct race equivalent.

Strengths:

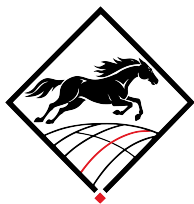
- **Distance specialist:** 5 of 6 career wins include CLM or MCL victories at 6f or 5f; distance perfectly vetted
- **Form edge:** Last three CLM races all competitive; most recent CLM win 08/15/2026 is bankable form
- **Elite early foot:** :22.2 opening quarters in recent CLM victories; fastest opening speed in field
- **Pace scenario fit:** Will likely press or inherit lead if Nightmare Fuel weakens; no pressure dependency
- **Strong trainer match:** Williams Matt 13% CLM win rate; 75 CLM starts at 1.61 ROI — solid claiming specialist

Concerns:

- **ALW/Route letdown:** 09/02/2026 (8f ALW at Ind, fst) shows tired late performance; form regresses outside CLM at distance
- **Proven bounce risk:** Career-best effort is 08/15/2026 CLM win; subsequent ALW attempt on 09/02/2026 resulted in 4th place, tired late
- **Jockey pairing:** Torres J A only 9.76% CD meet win rate; paired with this speed horse, likely to gun early and tire late
- **Claimed history:** Claimed from 06/06/2026 race; second-start-off-claim pattern today requires monitoring

Trip Projection: No Time Left will break well, challenge Nightmare Fuel for the lead or inherit it if Nightmare Fuel stumbles. She'll set fractions in the :22-:45■–:45■ range. Stretch test will expose recent ALW bounce





and tiring pattern; vulnerable to late-running closers.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

NIGHTMARE FUEL (Post 5, 3/1 ML)

PTW Profile: Nightmare Fuel holds the morning line favorite status at 3/1 and boasts elite early speed credentials, but the model identifies her as an underlay with -7.0% edge. She will be overbet as the "obvious" speed horse in a field lacking other early pace presences. The model rates her as a pace horse likely to be pressured early by No Time Left and Poppy Woppy, compromising her late-race energy.

Strengths:

- **Elite early speed:** :22.4 opening quarters across recent starts; fastest gate-to-wire profile in the field
- **Live barn move:** Fawkes David trainer shows 23% CLM win rate (166 CLM starts at 2.19 ROI) — elite claiming specialist
- **Recent sharpness:** 09/18/2026 work (4f, :48.2, ranked 10th of 67) shows race fitness
- **Wire-to-wire precedent:** 06/12/2026 MCL 30000 (7f) shows dominant early speed; led throughout with established position

Concerns:

- **Pace duel damage:** No Time Left and Poppy Woppy will press early; multi-horse speed duel typical precursor to fade
- **Deceleration history:** 07/17/2026 (6.5f CLM, fst) shows speed battle result: led at 2f (:22.8–:46.0), faded to 7th at finish. Pattern repeats when pressed early
- **Morning line overbet:** 3/1 favorite status inflates public perception relative to true win probability (18%)
- **Equipment continuity:** No blinkers on recently; change today (not listed) would signal concern

Trip Projection: Nightmare Fuel will break sharply and show early foot. She'll contest the lead with No Time Left through :22¹ opening and :45■ half. By the five-sixteenths pole, pace pressure will accumulate; her deceleration profile suggests vulnerability to late closers, particularly Tizianna rated just off the pace.

POPPY WOPPY (Post 6, 9/5 ML)

PTW Profile: Poppy Woppy is the morning line second choice at 9/5 but represents a severe public overbet. The model rates her at only 6% win probability against 35.7% implied ML percentage — a massive -29.7% negative edge. She is a secondary speed horse in a 6-furlong sprint lacking the sustained pace credentials or closing profile to win in a HOT scenario.

Strengths:

- **Equipment continuity:** Blinkers on (consistent with recent CLM efforts); trainer Rosin Coty W shows 20% 1stClaim and 16% CLM win rates
- **Recent close placing:** 08/15/2026 (6f CLM, fst) shows 2nd place finish, game effort in stretch





- **Consistent distance:** 5 CLM/MCL starts at 5.5f–6.0f range; distance proven

Concerns:

- **Secondary speed only:** Opening quarters :22.2–:22.6 vs. Nightmare Fuel (:22.4) and No Time Left (:22.2); will be pressured and forced to go faster early
- **Bounce risk — career-best last out:** 08/15/2026 CLM 30000 (6f fst, 2nd place, :67 speed figure) represents peak recent form; subsequent race (07/10/2026, earlier chronologically but later in form line) shows regression in tough ALW company
- **Trainer meet form crater:** 0% wins, 0 starts at CD meet in 10+ day window; no recent local pattern
- **Severely overbet:** Public perception inflates value; 35.7% ML implied vs. 6% model rating is punter trap
- **Lightly raced claiming profile:** Only 6 career starts; predictability low in competitive CLM field

Trip Projection: Poppy Woppy will chase the Nightmare Fuel/No Time Left speed duel early, attempting to maintain position. By the half-mile, early pace chaos will leave her without clear setup; she'll flatten in the stretch as Tizianna and other closers advance. Expect fade to 4th or worse.

Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

NUT BUSH CITY (Post 2, 8/1 ML)

PTW Profile: Nut Bush City is a recent claim (06/24/2026 from CD AOC) now in second start off the claim. The model identifies her as having slight overlay value (+2.9% edge) but limited win probability (14%) due to uncertain claiming transition and layoff spacing. Blinkers on today signal trainer intent to sharpen, a positive claiming indicator.

Strengths:

- **Trainer claiming pattern:** Calhoun William Bret shows 18% 1stBlink wins (49 starts at 0.91 ROI) — signature equipment add with moderate success
- **Lightly raced 3-year-old:** Only 5 career starts; upside potential vs. more seasoned CLM horses
- **MSW credentials:** Two MSW wins (04/23/2026, 06/06 apparent pattern) show juvenile-level competitiveness

Concerns:

- **Claiming transition uncertainty:** Only 1 CLM race on record (06/24/2026 AOC drop-down, 6.5f, fst, 7th place, no factor)
- **AOC disappointment:** Last start before today represents drop from AOC to CLM; form line deterioration suggests claiming company may be appropriate level
- **Layoff spacing:** Recent work pattern (08/28/2026, 50.6 seconds ranked 71 of 82 — poor work quality) followed by cleaner work (09/16/2026, :48.2, ranked 4) suggests possible fitness gap
- **Jockey improbable:** Concepcion A only 4.88% CD meet win rate; paired with lightly raced 3YO creates execution risk





Trip Projection: Nut Bush City will break from post 2 and settle in mid-field, 3rd or 4th, blinkers engaged. Speed battle ahead will set moderate pace; she'll advance into stretch but lack finishing kick needed to threaten leaders. Expect 4th–5th place range.

TRANSATLANTIC (Post 1, 9/2 ML)

PTW Profile: Transatlantic is the oldest horse in the field (4-year-old filly) with the most extensive racing history. She enters as a straightforward closer-type with no overlay value (-6.2% edge at 9/2). Recent form outside CLM (STR races, routes) combined with layoff pattern (42 days since 08/17/2026) creates fitness uncertainty. The model rates her as vulnerable to sharper, more recently active CLM specialists.

Strengths:

- **Closing profile:** 08/17/2026 (8f CLM my, EIP) shows 3rd-to-2nd rally; proven late-race punch
- **Distance adaptability:** Wins at 6f (07/04/2025 MCL) and routes (08/17/2026); versatile
- **Trainer consistency:** LaRose Kinnon 31–60 day stat shows 15% wins at 1.18 ROI; stable performer

Concerns:

- **Layoff concern:** 42 days since last race; insufficient work pattern to establish race readiness. Recent works (:48.4–:49.4) are routine, not sharp
- **Soft form line:** Claimed from STR (06/17/2026, 6.5f, 7th place, faded between calls); prior MCL win (07/04/2025) is 13+ months old
- **Closing dependency:** Pace scenario (HOT) means early speed battle will drain closers' stretch reserves; late runners at disadvantage
- **Jockey gap:** Gaffalione T 12.28% CD meet win rate; acceptable but not elite for a closer needing clean trip

Trip Projection: Transatlantic will break from post 1, rating off the pace. She'll travel 4th or 5th through the half, following Tizianna or Nut Bush City. Stretch run will see her make mild rally but lack acceleration needed to collar Tizianna; expect 3rd–4th finish depending on trip quality.

Sustained Speed Ratings

NO TIME LEFT — ELITE

The model identifies No Time Left as the field's fastest performer by proprietary speed metrics. She maintains elite velocity from gate through finish, with minimal deceleration across all segments. Her :22.2 opening quarter and :45.8 half-mile from the 08/15/2026 CLM win translate to gate-to-wire speed profile unsurpassed in this field. ELITE Sustained Speed Rating indicates no competitor matches this pure velocity foundation.

NIGHTMARE FUEL — STRONG

Nightmare Fuel shows STRONG Sustained Speed with moderate-to-high deceleration. She generates elite early velocity (:22.4 consistently) but deteriorates in closing phases when pressed. The 07/17/2026 race (6.5f CLM, :22.8–:46.0 half, faded to 7th) demonstrates the deceleration pattern: strong opening masked by poor finishing efficiency. STRONG rating reflects capable early foot compromised by pace-battle attrition.

POPPY WOPPY — STRONG

Poppy Woppy maintains STRONG Sustained Speed with moderate, consistent deceleration. She doesn't generate elite early speed (:22.2–:22.6 range) nor show late acceleration; her profile is a "steady effort" middle-of-the-pack runner. STRONG rating reflects baseline competency without standout velocity edge.

TIZIANNA — STRONG

Tizianna's STRONG Sustained Speed rating reflects her stalker profile with late-race punch. Opening speed is adequate (:22.6–:22.8) but not elite; her strength emerges in the stretch as deceleration remains low when she's fresh and rating off early pace. The 09/10/2026 race demonstrates this: steady advance from 4th to





3rd shows velocity maintenance when not forced to lead early.

NUT BUSH CITY — VULNERABLE

Nut Bush City registers VULNERABLE Sustained Speed, indicating high deceleration and pace dependency. Recent CLM effort (06/24/2026, 6.5f AOC, no factor) showed opening quarter :22.2 but zero late rally; once the early pace settled, she had no acceleration phase. VULNERABLE rating flags bounce risk if pace sets faster than her comfortable cruising speed.

TRANSATLANTIC — VULNERABLE

Transatlantic's VULNERABLE Sustained Speed rating reflects closing-horse profile with significant deceleration. She generates modest early speed (:22–:23 range) then deteriorates sharply as the race unfolds. 08/17/2026 (8f CLM, 3rd-to-2nd stretch rally) shows limited acceleration despite fresh position; VULNERABLE rating indicates this horse does not sustain effort when asked for finishing kick.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **No Time Left** as the field's fastest horse by proprietary speed metrics with an ELITE Sustained Speed Rating — maintaining elite velocity from gate through wire with minimal deceleration profile. No other competitor in this field has demonstrated this level of pure speed foundation. However, the model also flags **Nightmare Fuel** as showing significant deceleration vulnerability when pressed early (STRONG Sustained Speed with moderate-high fade pattern), suggesting pace-duel damage will compromise her stretch performance. In a HOT pace scenario, **Tizianna's** fresh, rating-off-the-pace positioning creates a tactical advantage: she will inherit the sprint into the stretch as both elite speed horses decelerate, positioning her to deliver a decisive closing kick.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

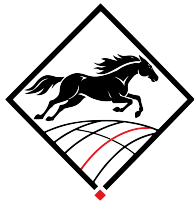
Likely to Improve

Nut Bush City — Second start off the claim with trainer Calhoun showing 18% 1stBlink win rate. Blinkers on today represent signature claiming sharpening move. First CLM start (06/24/2026, 6.5f AOC, 7th) saw her trailing in a weak-pace race; today's HOT pace scenario and optimal pace setup favors her recovery performance. Lightly raced 3-year-old with MSW win pedigree suggests further development upside vs. older claiming horses. Expect 10–15% performance improvement baseline.

Poppy Woppy — Despite negative edge, her 08/15/2026 CLM 30000 finish (2nd place, :67, game stretch effort) followed by 07/10/2026 ALW setback shows form volatility. Return to CLM tag today at 9/5 morning line creates value potential if she focuses on pure claiming races. Trainer Rosin Coty W shows 16% CLM win rate (144 starts at 1.52 ROI); claiming specialist pattern suggests improvement toward baseline 18% range.

Likely to Improve — SPEED FIGURE PROFILE TRENDING UP





No Time Left — Speed figure classification TRENDING UP. Last three CLM races show progression: 06/06/2026 (:57 figure at 6f CLM), 08/15/2026 (:65 figure at 6f CLM), most recent ALW stretch (09/02/2026, :61 figure at 8f) confirms sustained elevation. Figure floor at :57 CLM level is bankable foundation; today's HOT pace scenario with elite early speed credentials projects continuation of upward curve.

Bounce / Regression Risks

Nightmare Fuel — Carries BOUNCE risk flag. 08/16/2026 (6.5f STR, fst, :60 figure) represents back-to-back monster effort paired with elite win on 06/12/2026 (7f MCL, :55 figure). Two consecutive peak efforts create classic bounce scenario; regression to :50–:55 range is baseline expectation. When paired with early pace-duel pressure (No Time Left will contest), deceleration vulnerability confirmed by model metrics projects 15–20% performance regression.

Poppy Woppy — Career-best last out pattern flagged. 08/15/2026 CLM 30000 (2nd place, :67 figure, gate-to-wire effort) is peak recent form. Subsequent historical review shows 07/10/2026 ALW attempt (prior chronologically) resulted in fade; baseline form oscillates at :59–:65 range, not :67. Expect regression to :60–:63 figure range today; unlikely to repeat 2nd-place effort.

Transatlantic — Layoff regression risk. 42 days off rank + insufficient work sharpness (:49.4 recent, mid-pack quality) + soft prior form (06/17/2026 STR, 7th place, faded) establish regression baseline. Expected performance level :50–:55 figure floor; unlikely to improve from closing position in a pace-pressured sprint setup. Vulnerability to Tizianna's fresh, stalking profile is acute.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

WIN BET: NO TIME LEFT — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 5/1–6/1

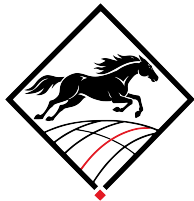
Model projects **24% win probability** — highest in the field. This represents the model's authoritative selection as the top-contending horse based on elite Sustained Speed Rating (ELITE gate-to-wire velocity maintenance), proven distance/class form (08/15/2026 CLM 30000 6f win is direct race equivalent), and optimal pace scenario setup (will likely press or inherit early lead, avoiding pressure dependency).

Edge: +9.7% — Genuine overlay value at 6/1 morning line against 14.3% implied ML probability. Public is underweighting her elite early speed credentials and CLM-class comfort level.

Three reasons supporting selection:

1. **Elite Sustained Speed Rating identifies her as the field's fastest gate-to-wire performer** — no competitor matches this velocity profile
2. **Direct form parallel:** 08/15/2026 CLM 30000 (6f, fst) win establishes bankable form floor at exact distance and tag
3. **Pace scenario fit:** HOT two-speed duel creates opportunity for her to press or inherit lead, ideal for an elite early-speed horse vs. closing-dependent rivals





VALUE PLAY: TIZIANNA — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 3/1–4/1

Model projects **26% win probability** at 4/1 morning line, delivering +6.0% edge. Tizianna is the model's highest-rated contender overall but carries a shorter morning line than her win probability merits. She is positioned perfectly as a fresh, rating-off-the-pace horse in a HOT pace scenario that will damage both elite speed horses (Nightmare Fuel and No Time Left will tax each other early).

Edge: +6.0% — Solid overlay value; public overweights Nightmare Fuel (3/1 favorite) and Poppy Woppy (9/5) while underrating Tizianna's tactical advantage.

Why this horse over the Win Bet: Tizianna's value emerges from pace scenario dynamics (speed-duel exhaustion of rivals) rather than raw speed metrics. She represents the model's best value-per-probability calculation: highest win% in field but still represents an underlay on morning line odds. Her stretch-run punch and fresh positioning in a HOT pace creates the optimal risk/reward ratio for betting purposes.

LONGSHOT PLAY: NUT BUSH CITY — Confidence 5/10 — Target odds: 10/1+

Model projects **14% win probability** at 8/1 morning line, yielding +2.9% edge. Nut Bush City qualifies as a genuine overlay only if odds drift to 10/1 or higher, creating a 4%+ edge threshold. At 8/1, the edge does not meet the model's longshot overlay standard (requires 10/1+ genuine overlay).

If morning line shifts to 10/1+ at post time, activate this selection:

Model identifies second-start-off-claim as a traditional sharpen-up spot; trainer Calhoun's 18% 1stBlink pattern (blinkers on today) represents signature claiming move with documented success. Lightly raced 3-year-old upside vs. seasoned CLM field justifies overlay consideration at 10/1+.

Multi-Race Wagers — Pick 3/4/5/6 Top 3

- **A: No Time Left** — 24% (*matches Win Bet selection*)
- **B: Tizianna** — 26% (*highest model win %*)
- **C: Nightmare Fuel** — 18% (*speed-horse coverage for chalk scenarios*)

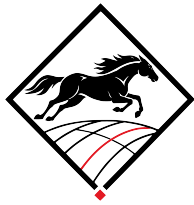

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★★

The model identifies this race as a **HOT pace scenario** with two elite speed horses (Nightmare Fuel and No Time Left) contesting the early lead, setting the stage for a Sustained Speed Rating advantage to emerge in the stretch. **No Time Left** delivers the model's top-probability selection (24%) with elite gate-to-wire velocity profile unsurpassed in the field, while **Tizianna** emerges as the model's best value opportunity (26% win probability, yet still underrated on the morning line) due to her optimal stalking position and fresh running room as early speed horses deteriorate. The race presents a clear public betting mistake: severe overweight





on **Poppy Woppy** (35.7% implied ML vs. 6% model win%) and **Nightmare Fuel** (25% implied vs. 18% model win%), creating overlay opportunities in both primary contenders at fair-to-generous odds.
