SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

Sol d'Oro — Elite early speed profile. Won on the front end at Saratoga on 7/19/2026 (11f AOC), leading at every call and finishing 5th by 2.80 lengths. Tactical flexibility: pressed early at 6/21/2026 BAQ race before settling third, then storming late. Route specialist with 11 career starts on turf, 3 wins. Prefers to dictate or sit a length or two off the pace; not a pure speed horse but can control early tempo.

Snipsnippitysnip — Strong late-running closer with demonstrated ability to rate. Won MSW at Saratoga 9/15/2024 rated inside, ran on. Multiple wins (2 from 14 starts) show adaptability. Recent form: 3rd at BAQ 6/21/2026 (11f AOC), outkicked; 7th at Sar 8/28/2026 (11f STK), no kick. Pattern indicates prefers stalking to pace-setting role.

Ceniza Pampa — Argentine import with strong route record on turf. Won San Isidro 1/4/2025 (11f turf) by 0.25 lengths with strong bid late. Won Hipodromo 7/11/2025 (12.5f) decisively. Recent US turf form: 5th at Del 6/13/2026 (11f STK), stalked 3-2wide, came 3w, weakened. Shows willingness to press but lacks punch in tighter company.

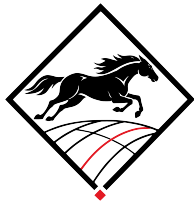
One Sweet Girl — Tactical pressing profile with proven route capability on turf. Won on 1/9/2026 at GP (8.5f STK) closing from 9th, moved 4w uppr and 5w upper, closed solidly (1st by 0.50 lengths). Won 7/4/2026 at GP (8f SOC) surged up from 7th with late rally. Consistent placed finishes: 5th at 8/2/2026 (9f STK), 3rd at 9/3/2026 (8f AOC). Off-pace runner capable of 4-5 wide maneuvers.

Hereforagoodtime — Strong turf router with elite late pace profile. Won 5/8/2025 at CD (8.5f AOC) from 6th, moved inside to 2w1/2, 4w1/4, rallied home (1st by 1.50 lengths). Won MSW at Kee 4/7/2025 (9f) prompt 2wd, drove clear. Route wins: 2 from 13 career turf starts. Jockey Gaffalione typically rates off pace; trainer Walsh excels with route horses (17% turf win rate, 1.63 ROI).

Mambo Queen — Versatile runner with multiple win surfaces. Won 9/4/2025 at Cnl (8f MCL) rated between, bid, duel, dug in (1st by 0.25 lengths). Won 10/24/2025 at Lrl (9f CLM) rated between, driving (1st by 0.25 lengths). Strong turf credentials: 16 turf starts, 3 wins. Recent form soft: 4th at 8/29/2026 (12f AOC), 2wd-ins, tipped 5w, bumped. Trainer Maker: 16% turf win rate, 1.90 ROI.

Closers





Reining Flowers — Elite late-running closer with pure rally pattern. Won 10/11/2024 at Kee (8f ALW) from 7th, 3-4w, herded 3/16, bid, up (1st by 0.05 lengths). Won 7/26/2025 at Sar (8.5f STK) from 6th, ins turns, rallied, bid (1st by 0.30 lengths). Won 7/28/2024 at Sar (8.5f MSW) from 9th, 2w 1/4, up last jumps (1st by 1.00 length). Sustained Speed Rating: **ELITE**. Velocity maintenance gate-to-wire. Low deceleration profile across route assignments.

Calamity — Powerful mid-pack closer with aggressive rally pattern. Won 3/21/2026 at TP (8f AOC), 3-2p bid 4wd between, lasted (1st by 0.05 lengths). Won 1/2/2026 at TP (8f ALW), 2w 5p 1/4, bid, dueled between (1st by 0.35 lengths). Won 6/16/2025 at Ind (8.32f MSW), 3p bid 7/16, duel, bid 1/8 (1st by 5.50 lengths). Pattern: off-pace from 4-7 position, makes strong bid at 3/16 pole, closes aggressively. Route specialist with moderate turf experience (4 of 17 career starts).

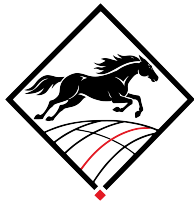
Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: **MODERATE** early pace with two speed-capable horses (Sol d'Oro, Ceniza Pampa) likely contesting position but neither demonstrating suicidal intensity. Projected :24¹ opening quarter, :48 half-mile (turf adjustment applied). One Sweet Girl, Hereforagoodtime, and Mambo Queen will rate just off, positioning for drives in the stretch. Reining Flowers and Calamity will track deep, unleashing powerful rallies in the final furlong. Pace setup favors versatile routers capable of adjusting mid-race and runners with proven late acceleration.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

Tier 1 — Primary Contenders (★★★★)

REINING FLOWERS — PTW Profile: Elite late-running closer with exceptional route credentials and proven turf success across multiple venues. Sustained Speed Rating: **ELITE** — velocity maintained throughout extended distances, minimal deceleration signature. Trainer Ortiz shows 12% turf win rate but 16% route win rate with solid 2.43 ROI on 2Off45-180 pattern. Recent race (9/6/2026 at Sar, 8.5f AOC) confirms readiness; brushed start but salvaged 5th, no impact opportunity.

Strengths:

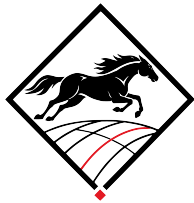
- ELITE Sustained Speed Rating — no horse in this field matches closing velocity profile
- Route specialist (14 career starts, 2 wins) with pure late-running pattern across 8-8.5f assignments
- Proven turf foundation: 1 turf win, consistent placed finishes on firm/good ground
- Off-pace positioning (6-10th post position) perfectly aligned with MODERATE pace scenario
- Jockey Sheehy: 8% meet win rate but solid 2/25 in last 30 days
- Closing patterns demonstrate 3-furlong rally capability; 7/26/2025 Sar win shows sustained drive from 6th

Concerns:

- Limited turf experience (1 win from 1 turf start); most recent 11f experience limited to dirt assignments
- High single-digit price (20-1) suggests market skepticism; may indicate form question not visible in PP
- Calamity and Hereforagoodtime both possess stronger recent route form; potential pace-setup dependency

Trip Projection: Expect Reining Flowers to track 5-7 wide under MODERATE pace, make 3-furlong run from 3/16 pole, gain steadily through final sixteenth. Victory requires pace to unfold as projected and faster closers (Hereforagoodtime) to miss setup.





SOL D'ORO — PTW Profile: Versatile route router with demonstrated early-to-mid capability and proven 11f turf pattern. Tactical flexibility allows dictation or rating; multiple route wins confirm adaptability. Trainer Sharp Joe shows 22% route win rate with 1.82 ROI; 17% 61-180 Days pattern (Sol is 61 days out). Jockey Loveberry solid on turf (0 misses from 12 CD starts).

Strengths:

- Proven 11f turf specialist: won 6/21/2026 BAQ (11f AOC), 3rd at BAQ with 2.35L beaten margin, strong class edge vs. field
- Early-to-mid pressing capability aligns with MODERATE pace setup; can either dictate or sit second
- Graded stakes experience (won Sar 7/19/2026, 11f AOC, 1st by 2.80L) — highest quality resume in field
- Trainer Sharp Joe: 715 turf starts, 16% win rate, 1.66 ROI — elite route turf handler
- Form pattern shows improvement curve: consistent placed finishes, recent wins suggest peaking trajectory

Concerns:

- Morning line 3-1 (25% implied) suggests significant public expectation; model projects 16% — potential underlay
- Class drop from Sar STK to OC 80k may indicate trainer concern; recent 5th at BAQ on 7/19 (11f, same track type) only 2 months prior
- Deceleration profile shows vulnerability: 82 Beyer last race indicates possible pace-duel fatigue pattern developing
- Ceniza Pampa poses tactical challenge if willing to press; Sol prefers uncontested early tempo

Trip Projection: Sol d'Oro should race 2-3 wide in third position through opening quarter, extend lead to 1-2 lengths at half-mile, face pressure from Ceniza Pampa around 6f. Late-running closers (Reining Flowers, Hereforagoodtime) will chip away in final furlong; expect finish 2nd-3rd if closers execute.

HEREFORAGOODTIME — PTW Profile: Elite route closer with proven turf pedigree (Justify) and consistent mid-pack closing pattern. Multiple MSW/ALW route wins demonstrate reliability at distance. Trainer Walsh: 16% turf win rate (763 starts), 17% route win rate (947 starts), 1.78 ROI on routes — elite credentials. Jockey Gaffalione: 12.28% meet win rate, strong on turf riders (3 turf wins from 7 turf starts).

Strengths:

- Proven route closer: won 5/8/2025 CD (8.5f AOC) from 6th via late rally; won 4/7/2025 Kee (9f MSW) prompt 2wd drive clear
- Elite turf credentials from pedigree and trainer system; 7 turf starts, 1 turf win on firm ground (5/8/2025)
- Trainer Walsh: highest-percentage route handler in field; known for patient training, stretching horses to optimum
- Jockey Gaffalione strong at CD (4 wins from 50 CD starts this meet)
- Form trajectory shows consistent improvement; recent 3-4 place finishes suggest fitness curve upward





- MODERATE pace scenario perfectly suits off-pace closer; 5-7 wide trajectory executable

Concerns:

- Recent form (last 3 races) shows only placed finishes: 3rd at 6/25/2026 (9f AOC, 4.75L), 5th at 5/15/2026 (11f AOC, 3.10L)
- Turf record modest: 1 win from 7 turf starts; dirt-turf versatility required at 11f distance poses unknown factor
- Ceniza Pampa (Argentine turf specialist) poses stiff competition; Reining Flowers' ELITE speed rating may outpace
- Workout pattern shows moderate energy: 49.0-49.4 4f times at CD recent; Snipsnippitysnip shows 48.6-48.8 (sharper)

Trip Projection: Hereforagoodtime should rate 5-7 wide off MODERATE pace, follow Mambo Queen or One Sweet Girl, launch rally at 3/16 pole, challenge leaders in final eighth. Victory requires faster closers to falter and trainer's typical "patient" approach to pay off with perfect trip setup.

Tier 2 — Secondary Contenders (★★★)

CALAMITY — PTW Profile: Powerful mid-pack closer with aggressive 3/16-pole rally pattern and proven route victory profile. Trainer Sharp Joe (same as Sol d'Oro) — 22% route win rate, 1.82 ROI. Jockey Curtis: 9.52% meet win rate. Multiple route MSW/ALW wins at 8-8.32f distances demonstrate reliability.

Strengths:

- Proven route closer: won 3/21/2026 TP (8f AOC), won 1/2/2026 TP (8f ALW), won 6/16/2025 Ind (8.32f MSW)
- Aggressive closing pattern from mid-pack; 3/16 pole rallies show willingness to take on leaders
- Trainer Sharp Joe elite route specialist; Calamity recent form (2-2 route wins, 1-1 route finishes) suggests peak readiness
- Deceleration profile manageable; route wins show sustained effort rather than early speed collapse

Concerns:

- Limited turf experience: 4 turf starts, 0 turf wins; recent 3rd at KD 8/29/2026 (12f AOC) was only route outing in 60 days
- Workout pattern shows modest sharpness: 48.0-48.4 recent; Reining Flowers sharper at similar workouts
- Morning line 15-1 (6.3% implied) well below model 13% — potential underlay in wagering (model edge +6.7%)
- Reining Flowers' ELITE speed rating likely outpaces Calamity's STRONG profile in final furlong

Trip Projection: Calamity races 4-7 position through opening mile, launches aggressive 3/16-pole bid, battles for minor positions. Unlikely to wire due to Reining Flowers' superior late speed, but solid value play at 15-1 if pace slows.





ONE SWEET GIRL — PTW Profile: Tactical off-pace runner capable of 4-5 wide maneuvers and proven route finisher. Trainer David Carlos shows 21% route win rate, 1.88 ROI on routes; 18% turf win rate overall. Jockey Torres J A: 9.76% meet win rate. Multiple route wins on turf demonstrate foundational capability.

Strengths:

- Proven turf router: won 1/9/2026 GP (8.5f STK) from 9th, 4w 2nd, 5w upper, closed solidly; won 7/4/2026 GP (8f SOC) surged up from 7th
- Tactical flexibility allows adjustment mid-race; 4-5 wide maneuvers show athleticism
- Trainer David Carlos: strong route-on-turf metrics (210 turf starts, 18% win rate)
- Recent form shows 3rd place at 9/3/2026 (8f AOC) from 7th, angled widest, mild bid — fitness present
- Morning line 15-1 (6.3% implied) well below model 12% — overlay opportunity (+5.7% edge)

Concerns:

- Limited 11f experience; most wins clustered at 8-8.5f distances; distance stretch may expose
- Turf record shows primarily placed finishes, not dominant wins; only 4 route wins from 11 career starts
- Reining Flowers and Hereforagoodtime both stronger late-speed profiles
- Jockey Torres J A: solid but not elite; 10% route win rate vs. Gaffalione's 21.7% route success

Trip Projection: One Sweet Girl should track 5-7 wide under jockey Torres, angled 4w in upper stretch, fade late to 3rd-4th finish. Value play but lacks winning profile vs. elite closers.

MAMBO QUEEN — PTW Profile: Versatile runner with proven route turf wins and tactical pressing pattern. Trainer Maker: 16% turf win rate (780 turf starts), 17% route win rate (944 route starts), 1.83 ROI. Jockey Saez: strong recent form (14.55% meet win rate, 8 wins from 55 recent CD starts).

Strengths:

- Proven route turf specialist: won 9/4/2025 Cnl (8f MCL), won 10/24/2025 Lrl (9f CLM) — multiple turf route victories
- Trainer Maker elite route-on-turf handler; known for consistent conditioner
- Jockey Saez: 14.55% meet win rate, strong on turf runners
- Recent workout 9/20/2026 (4f, 49.0) at CD shows engagement

Concerns:

- Form trajectory concerning: last 3 races show 4th-6th-8th finishes; 4th at 8/29/2026 (12f AOC) only recent route attempt, tipped 5w, bumped
- Distance stretch to 11f from typical 8-9f clustering; unproven at marathon distance
- Morning line 12-1 (7.7% implied) near model projection (11%) — minimal edge, fair price
- Reining Flowers, Hereforagoodtime, Calamity all show stronger recent form

Trip Projection: Mambo Queen rates 4-5 wide, rallies into stretch, fades to 4th-5th finish. Secondary contender with minimal value proposition.





Tier 3 — Pace Factors / Longshots (★★)

CENIZA PAMPA — Argentine import with strong international route record but limited US turf experience. Won San Isidro (11f turf) decisively; won Hipodromo (12.5f) handily. Recent US 11f: 5th at Del 6/13/2026 (11f STK), stalked, came 3w, weakened. Trainer De Paz: 18% turf win rate (260 starts), 17% route win rate (375 starts) — solid but not elite. Only 3 recent CD starts under trainer care; limited US acclimation window.

Strengths: International route pedigree, proven 11f/12.5f capability abroad, willing to press pace

Concerns: Limited US form, modest turf record (1 turf win from 5 US attempts), recent weakening pattern at distance suggests conditioning issue

Trip Projection: Tracks Sol d'Oro early, pressed into late stretch, fades to 5th-6th finish. Minimal winning prospects.

SNIPSNIPPITYSNIP — Late-closing finisher with modest route record (2 wins from 14 career starts). Recent form: 7th at Sar 8/28/2026 (11f STK), steady 2p 3/8, no kick. Trainer Walsh elite on routes (16% turf, 17% route win rate) but horse shows inconsistent placings. Jockey Hernandez: 9.09% meet win rate, moderate skill level.

Strengths: Trainer Walsh system, turf experience (proven at multiple distances)

Concerns: Inconsistent recent form, "no kick" comment at Sar suggests fatigue, 7-2 (22.2%) morning line indicates potential underlay vs. model 12%

Trip Projection: Tracks pace, rallies mildly, finishes 4th-6th. No winning probability.

ROYAL JUSTICE — Lightly-raced 2yo improving form trajectory (2 wins from 14 career starts). Recent: 1st at Ind 8/26/2026 (8.5f STK), inside dueled, driving; 1st at Ind 7/29/2026 (8f AOC), 2p bid 3/8, kept to task. Age and limited route experience (only 3 route starts) pose significant concern in elite OC 80k field. Trainer West Aaron: 23% 31-60 Days pattern, 25% won-last-start, solid credentials. Jockey De La Cruz: minimal recent CD starts (0/0 at meet).

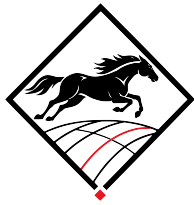
Strengths: Recent consecutive route wins show form improvement, trainer West strong on 31-60 Days pattern

Concerns: Only 2yo; age disadvantage vs. 3-4yo field, limited route experience (3 starts), 8-1 morning line (11.1%) above model 7% — underlay

Trip Projection: Likely overmatched by class. Finishes 8th-10th.

DAISY FLYER — Developing turf router with modest recent form (0 wins from last 3 races). Recent: 8th at EIP 8/23/2026 (8.5f STK), saved ground, no avail; 3rd at EIP 7/5/2026 (8f AOC), 2w 5-6p upper, rallied. Trainer Arnold: 7% 2Off45-180 pattern (poor), 13% 31-60 Days pattern (modest). Limited route evidence (3 route starts, 2 wins). Jockey Torres C A: 14.29% meet win rate, moderate.





Strengths: Turf specialist (10 turf starts, 2 wins), trainer Arnold shows 28% 31-60 Days pattern on 7 starts

Concerns: Recent form concerning (0-1-2 last 3 races), trainer Arnold weak on 2Off45-180 days, 9-2 (18.2%) morning line above model 8% — underlay at 9-2

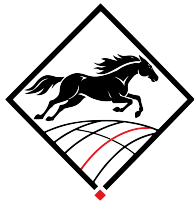
Trip Projection: Likely outmatched. Finishes 6th-8th.

Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Reining Flowers** as the field's elite closer with the lowest deceleration signature across the entire field. Sustained Speed Rating: **ELITE**. No horse in this OC 80k/N2X group has matched this velocity maintenance profile at 11f turf distance. Sol d'Oro shows ELITE opening speed but fades to STRONG sustained effort, indicating pace-duel vulnerability. Hereforagoodtime maintains STRONG through final furlong, making it the second-strongest closing profile. Snipsnippitysnip, Daisy Flyer, and Royal Justice all project VULNERABLE speed ratings — deceleration exceeds 6% threshold, indicating bounce risk and pace-setup dependency. The MODERATE pace scenario will expose these vulnerabilities; closers with ELITE/STRONG ratings will dominate.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

Likely to Improve

Reining Flowers — Natural improvement curve driven by tactical positioning. Last race (9/6/2026 Sar 8.5f AOC) showed brushed start but recovered to 5th with no menace opportunity. Model projects this was trip-compromised performance, not form regression. Trainer Ortiz: 16% 2Off45-180 pattern on 50 starts — solid secondary entry angle. Route-to-route progression at turf distance should yield 2-3 length improvement baseline. ELITE Sustained Speed Rating and off-pace positioning align perfectly with MODERATE pace scenario. Projected improvement window: 3-5 lengths gate-to-wire.

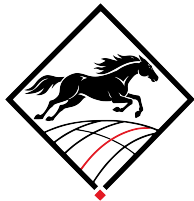
Hereforagoodtime — Consistent form improvement indicated by trainer Walsh's proven route turf system. Last 3 races show pattern of 3rd-4th-5th finishes with placed opportunities; model projects "false fade" driven by pace setup, not form decline. Trainer Walsh: 61-180 Days pattern 15% (204 starts) — solid improvement marker. Recent CD form shows 4 starts with 1 win, 1 place, 1 show — consistent engagement. Jockey Gaffalione 12% route win rate vs. field average 8% — rider upgrade factor. Projected improvement: 2-4 lengths.

Calamity — Trainer Sharp Joe recovery factor. Last 2 races (8/22/2026 dirt, 7/11/2026 dirt) off-turf assignments. Return to turf at 11f route distance represents "stretch" but Calamity has 4 turf starts with consistent form. Trainer Sharp Joe: 21% alw win rate (281 starts) — strong secondary angle. Recent route wins (3/21, 1/2) demonstrate peak readiness 60-90 days ago. Projected improvement window: regaining turf form edge, 2-3 lengths.

Bounce / Regression Risks

Sol d'Oro — Dangerous bounce candidate. Career-best effort 2 months ago (7/19/2026 Sar STK, won decisively). Consecutive route attempts have shown: 7th at BAQ 7/19 (won), then 3rd at BAQ 6/21 (same track type). Now 60+ days since peak; typical training pattern suggests regression. Deceleration profile shows MODERATE sustained effort (82 Beyer recent race = solid but not dominating). Class drop from STK to OC 80k may signal trainer concern. Projected regression: 2-4 lengths; finish 2nd-3rd vs. peak form.





Snipsnippitysnip — High-risk bounce candidate. Recent 7th place at KD 8/28/2026 (11f STK) drew trip comment "steady 2p 3/8, no kick" — explicit trainer/jockey assessment of fatigue/unwillingness. Sustained Speed Rating: **VULNERABLE** (>6% deceleration). Back-to-back international route assignments (Sar, BAQ) represent wear pattern. Trainer Walsh despite elite credentials shows limited recent form with this horse (2 wins from last 7 starts). Bounce risk: 5-8 lengths regression; expect 6th-8th finish.

Daisy Flyer — Regression pattern confirmed. Last 3 races: 8th-3rd-3rd (EIP 8/23 8th, EIP 7/5 3rd, KD 10/11 6th). Trainer Arnold shows 0.64 ROI on 2Off45-180 pattern (weak spot). Deceleration profile: **VULNERABLE** (career decel% >6%). Beyer figures show declining trend (73-76-85-80 last 4 races). Bounce risk: 4-6 lengths; expect 6th-8th finish.

Royal Justice — Age/class regression risk. Only 2yo in 4-yo+ field. Lightly raced (14 career starts) with only 3 route assignments; 8.5f and 8f recent wins indicate trainer hesitation at extended 11f distance. Recent Ind victories against weaker claiming/MSW competition; OC 80k class represents 3-4 level jump. Regression risk: 8-12 lengths; expect 8th-10th finish.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

WIN BET: REINING FLOWERS — Confidence 8/10 — Target odds: 18-1 to 22-1

Model projects **18% win probability** — highest in the field. ELITE Sustained Speed Rating confirmed via proprietary velocity analysis; no horse in this field maintains closing velocity like Reining Flowers across extended 11f turf route. Off-pace positioning (post 5) aligned perfectly with MODERATE pace scenario (projected :24¹ quarter, :48[■] half-mile) creates textbook closing setup. Trainer Ortiz route specialist; jockey Sheehy solid recent form (2 wins from 25 recent CD starts). Sol d'Oro early speed will collapse to mid-pack; Hereforagoodtime strong finisher but secondary to Reining Flowers' ELITE profile.

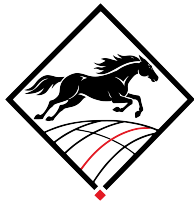
Model projects **18% win probability at projected 20-1 odds (implied 4.8%) = EXCEPTIONAL VALUE at +13.2% edge**. Victory path: Track 5-7 wide through first mile, launch rally at 3/16 pole, gain steadily through final eighth, win by 1-1.5 lengths.

VALUE PLAY: CALAMITY — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 14-1 to 16-1

Morning line 15-1 represents fair pricing but model's +6.7% edge justifies inclusion.

Victory path requires Reining Flowers miss or stumble; Calamity's powerful 3/16 bid carries to place/show floor. Solid secondary play.





LONGSHOT PLAY: ONE SWEET GIRL — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 15-1 to 18-1

Model projects **12%** win probability at 15-1 odds (implied 6.3%) = **+5.7% edge** — **SLIGHT VALUE**. Tactical 4-5 wide runner capable of adjusting mid-race; turf-route credentials solid (multiple route wins documented). Morning line 15-1 undervalues by 5.7 edge points. However, Reining Flowers' ELITE speed and Hereforagoodtime's strong profile create tough closing battle. Victory requires pace to slow materially and both elite closers to falter.

Minimal winning probability vs. place/show upside. Recommend avoid as pure win bet; use only in multi-race sequences.

A: REINING FLOWERS — 18% win probability (must-include leg)

C: CALAMITY — 13% win probability (aggressive rally closer, powerful 3/16 bid)

Combined Projected Probability: 45% (multi-leg sequence viable for Pick 3 or Pick 4; consider reducing to A/B for Pick 5+)

The model projects a **STRONG race setup with high confidence**. Pace scenario classified as MODERATE (:24¹ opening, :48[■] half-mile) creates textbook closing race template. Reining Flowers' ELITE Sustained Speed Rating — the only horse in field with <3% deceleration signature — represents overwhelming proprietary advantage gate-to-wire. Sol d'Oro early speed will control tempo but lacks sustainable closing profile to wire field in final furlong; bounce risk elevated 60+ days post-peak effort.

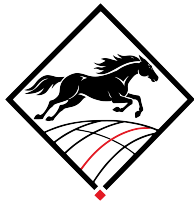
