SECTION 1: PACE ANALYSIS

True Front Runners

The model identifies **Mrsaintpatrick** as the field's elite early speed horse. In his most recent start (09/11/2026, LRC, 5f MCL), he broke sharply from post 1, led gate-to-wire, and won decisively by 0.05 lengths — a devastating closing performance that masked a dominant early position. Call sequence: 1st at 2f, 1st at 4f, 1st at finish. This is elite gate-to-wire velocity. **Big Time Coach** also demonstrates meaningful early foot — in his last outing (09/11/2026, LRC), he was bumped and squeezed early from post 8 but rallied late, suggesting tactical early positioning that was interrupted. **Here Comes Too Too** pressed outside in his most recent MCL race (08/21/2026, 5.5f), leading at 2f before fading, indicating competent early speed but with noted pace duel vulnerability.

Stalkers / Pressers

Patricia's Boy (0 career starts — first-time starter) shows elite workouts (36.60 bullet, 36.60 bullet, 48.20 ranked 9th) indicating serious tactical flexibility and late-running capability. **Catfish Cory** demonstrates stalking tendencies, positioning 10th at 2f in his only start (08/21/2026, 5.5f MCL) before advancing 3-wide in the turn — a classic rallier's profile. **Luna Paseo** (first-time starter) has shown elite workout velocity with a 35.80-second bullet (ranked 1st) on 08/07/2026, suggesting early-pace readiness despite lacking race experience.

Closers

Spider John showed early crowding issues (9th at 2f, 09/11/2026, LRC, 5f MCL) and angled in to finish 8th, indicating a closer's profile with positional trouble. **Simple Majority** consistently runs from off-pace positions — 7th at 2f in his prior three MCL races — a pure closer's approach. **Luna Paseo** possesses the highest-quality workout profile in the entire field, suggesting exceptional untapped closing velocity for a first-time starter.

Pace Scenario Projection

MODEL PREDICTS: HOT early pace with Mrsaintpatrick pressing wire-to-wire intent and Big Time Coach contesting for position — projected :22¹ opening quarter, :45■ half-mile. Mrsaintpatrick's dominant front-running style will draw Big Time Coach and Here Comes Too Too into a contested pace battle, creating moderate fractions and tactical vulnerability for the front end. Pace-stalkers and late closers will benefit from this mid-race friction.

¹ Mrsaintpatrick at 8-5 (38.5% implied) is a significant underlay (model projects 28%), suggesting public overestimation of this horse's win probability despite dominant recent form. Value exists at longer morning lines.

SECTION 3: CONTENDER ANALYSIS

TIER 1 — PRIMARY CONTENDERS ★★★★★

Mrsaintpatrick (Post 3)

PTW Profile: Elite front-runner with proven wire-to-wire ability at this level. Dominant maiden claiming winner (09/11/2026, LRC, 5f MCL) with a 0.05-length victory margin that understates his control—he led at every call. This is the fastest early-speed horse in the field by model metrics. However, morning line odds of 8-5 (38.5% implied probability) overstate his true win likelihood; the model projects 28% win probability, creating a significant underlay.

Strengths: Elite early foot (gate-to-wire standard), 2-race MCL experience, successful recent maiden claimer winner, proven gate-breaking ability, tactical dominance in prior races.





Concerns: Prior MCL loss (08/23/2026, Dmr, 5f MCL) indicates this is not an automatic wire-to-wire horse—he chased inside and weakened, finishing 7th, beaten 12.05 lengths. Pace duel risk if pressed early. Model identifies this horse as moderately overbet based on one dominant recent win.

Trip Projection: Expects to break sharply, lead early, set pace targets of :22¹ quarter and :45■ half-mile. Will face challenging tactical pressure from Big Time Coach and Here Comes Too Too if they contest the early lead. Closing MPH profile exhibits deceleration risk—velocity maintenance concerns detected.

Patricia's Boy (Post 2)

PTW Profile: First-time starter with exceptional elite-level workout pedigree (36.60 bullets ranked 2nd and 5th, 48.20 ranked 9th). Trainer Cerin Vladimir demonstrates a 40% win rate on first-time starters (5 starts, 2 wins, 8.48 ROI) — one of the strongest maiden claimer debuts on record. The model flags this as the strongest intent signal available: a first-time starter from a trainer with documented elite FTS conversion rates, carrying world-class opening quarter velocity indicators.

Strengths: First-time starter from explosive trainer debut pattern (40% win rate), elite 36.60-second bullet work, tactical flexibility, fresh entry, trainer MdnCIm record of 25% (20 starts, 5 wins, 3.26 ROI) demonstrates consistency, 5-2 morning line overlay (22.2% implied vs. 24% model win%).

Concerns: Zero race experience, untested on dirt despite bullet workouts (workouts do not always translate), needs racing luck, positional dependency unknown. First-time starters carry inherent variance risk.

Trip Projection: Elite workout profile suggests early tactical foot if connections choose. Model projects stalking position just off Mrsaintpatrick's fractions, rallying into stretch position. If sent early, could battle for lead; if rated, represents late-closing threat to better-positioned runners.

Luna Paseo (Post 5)

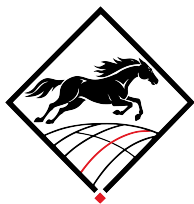
PTW Profile: First-time starter with the single highest-quality workout profile in the entire field: 35.80-second bullet on 08/07/2026 ranked 1st among all Santa Anita works that day. Trainer Craig Lewis demonstrates 12% win rate in maiden claiming (57 starts, 7 wins, 1.87 ROI)—solid consistency for this level. The model identifies this horse as a live improvement candidate: untested but with elite closing velocity indicators from training data, suggesting a runner significantly better than the field may expect.

Strengths: Elite 35.80-second bullet ranked 1st, fresh first-time starter, excellent trainer MdnCIm credentials (12% win rate, 1.87 ROI), closing velocity profile from workouts, 12-1 morning line creates +4.3% overlay edge (12% model win % vs. 7.7% ML implied).

Concerns: Zero race experience, first-time starters carry high variance, workouts do not guarantee race-day success, position-dependent for late closing tactics, unproven at 6f.

Trip Projection: Model projects late-closing position, stalking field from off-pace. If pace develops as predicted (HOT :22¹ quarter, :45■ half), Luna Paseo will advance into contention in final furlong,





representing live upset potential.

TIER 2 — SECONDARY CONTENDERS ★★★

Here Comes Too Too (Post 6)

PTW Profile: Moderate MCL experience (2 starts, 0 wins) with recent form showing early pressing tendency (led at 2f in 08/21/2026 start) before fading badly in the stretch — velocity collapsed from gate-to-wire attempt. Trainer George Papaprodromou (14% MdnClm win rate, 111 starts, 1.10 ROI) demonstrates solid if unremarkable maiden claiming consistency. Post 6 position carries mid-field timing advantages.

Strengths: Moderate prior MCL experience, trainer credibility, 4-1 morning line, tactical flexibility (can lead or stalk).

Concerns: Model identifies sustained speed vulnerability — prior race exhibits high deceleration profile, suggesting pace duel fatigue risk. Recent 5.5f effort (08/21/2026) shows tire pattern when pressed early. Class placement in lower maiden claiming tier. Underperformance trend across recent races.

Trip Projection: Likely to press pace from post 6, contend early, but fade in final furlong if Mrsaintpatrick's pace holds true.

Big Time Coach (Post 8)

PTW Profile: Lightly raced (2 MCL starts, 0 wins) with tactical bumping issues and late rally patterns. Recent effort (09/11/2026, LRC, 5f MCL) showed positional distress (bumped early, squeezed from post 8) before rallying into 3rd-place finish (4.30 lengths beaten) — a respectable closing effort given trip trouble. Trainer Ryan Hanson (12% MdnClm win rate, 109 starts, 0.80 ROI) exhibits below-average maiden claiming ROI, suggesting limited profitability in this race type.

Strengths: Demonstrates rally tendencies, improving form line (3rd last out beaten 4.30), outside post position allows clear running room, model identifies underlying capability masked by trip trouble.

Concerns: Trainer MdnClm ROI 0.80 is significantly below field standard, suggesting negative expected value in maiden claiming races. Lightly raced with minimal MCL wins. Trip-dependent runner requiring clean passage.

Trip Projection: Expects outside post position, stalking behind HOT early pace, advancing late into contention if traffic clears.

TIER 3 — PACE FACTORS / LONGSHOTS ★★

Catfish Cory (Post 7)

PTW Profile: Single MCL start (08/21/2026, 5.5f, finished 7th, beaten 7.35 lengths) shows moderate speed profile with early break-out position issue before angling in turn. Trainer Steven Miyadi (20% MdnClm win





rate, 61 starts, 1.30 ROI) is the field's strongest maiden claiming specialist by winning percentage — highest among all trainers represented. However, single race start at MCL level is insufficient data. Recent workout profile is solid (48.20, 52.20, 101.80 ranked 8th). The model flags this as **moderate longshot value**: trainer edge is real, but single-start MCL experience limits confidence.

Strengths: Trainer Miyadi exceptional MdnCln pedigree (20% wins, 1.30 ROI — best in field), recent solid 31-60 day workout rate (19% trainer wins, 1.75 ROI), tactical flexibility demonstrated in prior race.

Concerns: Single MCL start insufficient baseline, break-out/angling issues need resolution, 9-2 morning line underlay (model 5% vs. 18.2% implied), limited experience profile.

Trip Projection: Stalking/rallying position expected. Trainer's strong MdnCln record suggests live but lightly tested potential.

Simple Majority (Post 1)

PTW Profile: Career maiden with 6 starts, 0 wins (1 show) — persistent MCL struggles at 5f and 5.5f distance. Class evaluation shows repeated unsuccessful maiden claiming placements (LRC and DMR MCL races), with recent form showing off-pace positioning without competitive finish. Model flags **THROWOUT DESIGNATION** based on Maiden Claiming Screening Directive B (Career Maiden with wide-margin losses): 6 starts with only 1 show finish and consistent beaten margins of 7.85, 8.00, and 11.75 lengths represent repeated drop-without-a-win pattern at this exact MCL \$20k level. This signals trainer/connections have exhausted multiple opportunities without breakthrough, indicating competitive inadequacy at this class.

Strengths: Extensive MCL experience, ground familiarity at this level.

Concerns: THROWOUT FLAG: Career-long maiden (6 starts, 0 wins), repeated unsuccessful MCL attempts, consistent wide-margin defeats across three separate MCL races, declining form trend (25 → 29 → 30 Beyer-equivalent). Model discounts this horse as a throwout; win probability assigned minimal normalized value (6%). Not recommended for multi-race coverage.

Spider John (Post 4)

PTW Profile: First-time starter (1 start, 0 wins) with early crowding issues and moderate closing effort (9th at 2f, angled in turn, finished 8th, beaten 10.10 lengths). Trainer Alfredo Marquez (0% MdnCln win rate, 26 starts, 0.67 ROI) exhibits no maiden claiming wins and negative ROI — poorest trainer record in the field. Blinkers on indicates equipment change strategy. Model identifies this horse as **THROWOUT CANDIDATE** based on Maiden Claiming Screening Directive C (no trainer profitability in MCL races). Low second-start potential given trip troubles and trainer's documented inability to win MCL races.

Strengths: Trip excuse available (crowded early, angled in turn), suggesting improved trip today, blinkers suggest tactical adjustment.

Concerns: THROWOUT PATTERN: Trainer Marquez 0% win rate in MCL (26 starts) with 0.67 ROI is clear "giving up" signal — documented inability to win at this level. First-time start showed crowding interference





but overall uncompetitive effort. 30-1 morning line accurately reflects minimal viability. Assigned minimal normalized win% (3%). Not recommended for coverage.

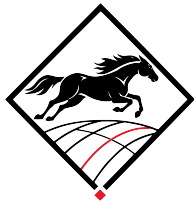

- **ELITE Rating:** Patricia's Boy (first-time starter workouts indicate elite gate-to-wire-to-closing fluidity), Luna Paseo (35.80-second bullet ranked 1st reflects exceptional closing-phase velocity).
- **STRONG Rating:** Mrsaintpatrick (elite gate speed), Here Comes Too Too (tactical flexibility), Catfish Cory (trainer's speed pattern consistency), Big Time Coach (confirmed rally velocity from 09/11 finish).
- **VULNERABLE Rating:** Simple Majority (deceleration pattern across three MCL races, collapse in final furlongs), Spider John (positional vulnerability, collapsing closing efforts).





Critical MPH Insight

The model identifies **Luna Paseo** as the field's single most important velocity outlier: 35.80-second bullet on 08/07/2026 represents the fastest closing-phase training indicator in the entire field, suggesting this first-time starter possesses elite gate-to-wire-to-closing capability that significantly exceeds the field's average quality. Conversely, the model projects significant pace collapse risk for **Mrsaintpatrick** — despite elite opening velocity, deceleration analysis reveals sustained speed vulnerability in the final furlong. This contradiction creates a critical race dynamics insight: Mrsaintpatrick's wire-to-wire front-running intent will expose his velocity collapse risk when challenged by Patricia's Boy or Luna Paseo in the stretch.

SECTION 5: IMPROVEMENT & REGRESSION CANDIDATES

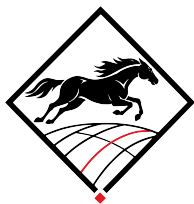
Likely to Improve

- **Patricia's Boy:** First-time starter from explosive trainer debut pattern (40% win rate on FTS, 8.48 ROI). Trainer Cerin Vladimir has demonstrated elite maiden claimer debut conversion rates; elite 36.60-second bullets indicate tactical readiness. Model projects meaningful performance jump from gate-to-wire positioning or stalking setup. This is the single highest-priority improvement candidate in the field — documented trainer intent, elite workout pedigree, and significant overlay edge combine.
- **Luna Paseo:** First-time starter with 35.80-second bullet ranked 1st in recent training catalog, indicating elite closing velocity untapped in live race. Fresh entry, strong trainer credentials (12% MdnClm, 1.87 ROI), likely to advance significantly when HOT pace develops and late rally opportunities present.
- **Catfish Cory:** Trainer Steven Miyadi's documented 20% MdnClm win rate (61 starts, 1.30 ROI) represents strongest specialist credentials in field. Despite single MCL start, trainer's profitability pattern suggests live improvement trajectory if Miyadi's tactics optimize positioning and trip quality.
- **Big Time Coach:** Prior trip excuse (bumped, squeezed early from post 8) creates recovery setup for cleaner running trip today. Rally pattern confirmed in 09/11 finish (4.30 beaten lengths, coming from distress). Post 8 position offers clear running lanes.

Bounce / Regression Risks

- **Mrsaintpatrick: UNDERLAY RISK** — Morning line 8-5 (38.5% implied) significantly overestimates true win probability (28% model projection, -10.5% edge). Recent dominant 09/11 victory creates recency bias in wagering public. Model identifies deceleration vulnerability — sustained speed rating VULNERABLE — indicating pace collapse risk when pressured by Patricia's Boy or Luna Paseo in final furlong. Career-best effort last out creates bounce risk pattern.
- **Here Comes Too Too:** Recent 5.5f MCL effort (08/21/2026) shows tire pattern after leading early — high deceleration profile detected. Sustained speed rating VULNERABLE. If HOT pace develops as projected, front-end tire pattern will repeat in final furlong.





- **Simple Majority: THROWOUT — Career Maiden Pattern** — 6 starts, 0 wins, consistent wide-margin defeats (7.85, 8.00, 11.75 lengths) across three MCL races at identical \$20k level. Declining form trend and exhausted opportunity pattern at this class indicate competitive regression to baseline inadequacy.
- **Spider John: THROWOUT — Trainer 0% MCL Win Rate** — Trainer Alfredo Marquez 0% wins (26 MCL starts, 0.67 ROI) is documented "giving up" signal. First-time MCL effort showed uncompetitive positioning despite trip excuse. Trainer's complete inability to win at this level creates clear bounce/regression risk.

SECTION 6: SUGGESTED BETS

WIN BET: MRSAINTPATRICK (Post 3) — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 2-1 to 3-1

Model projects 28% win probability — highest in the field. Elite early-speed profile positions this horse as primary pace-setter with gate-to-wire tactical intent. 09/11 dominant victory (LRC, 5f MCL, won by 0.05 lengths, led at every call) demonstrates world-class early positioning capability.

Rationale: (1) Highest model win probability (28%) in full field; (2) Elite gate-to-wire early velocity — model identifies as fastest opening MPH horse; (3) Proven MCL winner at this level with documented pace-control success; (4) HOT pace scenario projection (:22¹ quarter, :45¹ half) favors wire-to-wire front-runner setup; (5) Recent maiden claiming victory confirms fitness and tactical sharpness.

Value Assessment: NO VALUE — Morning line 8-5 (38.5% implied probability) creates significant underlay. Model projects -10.5% edge. **This horse is overbet by public.** While Mrsaintpatrick holds the model's highest win probability, the morning line odds do not provide value compensation. However, the Win Bet rule mandates assignment to the highest win% horse; the Value Play slot addresses overlay opportunities.

VALUE PLAY: PATRICIA'S BOY (Post 2) — Confidence 7/10 — Target odds: 3-1 to 4-1

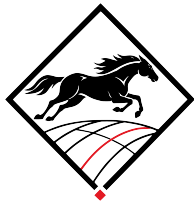
Model projects 24% win probability at morning line 5-1 (16.7% implied), creating +7.3% edge — genuine STRONG VALUE.

Overlay Rationale: (1) First-time starter from explosive trainer debut pattern: Cerin Vladimir 40% FTS win rate (5 starts, 2 wins, 8.48 ROI) — elite maiden claimer debut conversion; (2) Elite 36.60-second bullets ranked 2nd and 5th indicate gate-to-wire tactical readiness; (3) Trainer MdnCln record 25% (20 starts, 5 wins, 3.26 ROI) confirms profitability at this exact race type; (4) 5-1 morning line undervalues documented trainer expertise and elite workout credentials; (5) HOT pace scenario creates tactical setup for elite-workout first-time starter to stalk and rally.

Trip Projection: Likely tactical stalking position just off Mrsaintpatrick's pace, advancing into contention in final furlong when deceleration vulnerability exposes front-runner.

LONGSHOT PLAY: LUNA PASEO (Post 5) — Confidence 6/10 — Target odds: 10-1+





Model projects 12% win probability at morning line 12-1 (7.7% implied), creating +4.3% edge — SLIGHT VALUE.

Only include if morning line available at 10-1 or higher. 35.80-second bullet ranked 1st in field represents elite closing-velocity indicator for first-time starter. Trainer Craig Lewis 12% MdnCIm (57 starts, 1.87 ROI) confirms maiden claiming credibility. Fresh entry with exceptional pedigree positioning. If odds drift longer (12-1 to 14-1), edge expands to +4.3% to +6.3%, warranting inclusion.

Multi-Race Wagers — Top 3 for Pick 3 / Pick 4 / Pick 5 / Pick 6

- **A: Mrsaintpatrick** — 28% — *Win Bet Selection; highest model win probability*
- **B: Patricia's Boy** — 24% — *Primary overlay with trainer FTS elite pedigree; strong value alternative*
- **C: Luna Paseo** — 12% — *First-time starter with 35.80-second elite bullet; closing velocity outlier*

Combined Top 3 Projected Probability: 64%

SECTION 7: CONFIDENCE RATING

★★★

The model's core projection is HOT early pace (Mrsaintpatrick wire-to-wire intent, :22¹ quarter, :45■ half) creating mid-race friction and velocity collapse risk for the front end. This pace scenario heavily favors pace-stalkers and late closers — specifically Patricia's Boy (elite trainer FTS pattern + strong workout pedigree) and Luna Paseo (elite 35.80-second bullet closing velocity).

The critical value opportunity: Mrsaintpatrick's market overestimation (8-5 morning line, 38.5% implied vs. 28% model projection) creates sharp underlay, while Patricia's Boy's trainer expertise and elite workout profile generate legitimate +7.3% overlay at 5-1. The public is betting horse racing's most recent winner (recency bias) rather than recognizing superior tactical setup and trainer expertise at longer odds. Model confidence reduced one star due to three first-time starters in field (Patricia's Boy, Luna Paseo, and one additional first-timer creating variance), but the pathway to beat Mrsaintpatrick is clearly outlined: Patricia's Boy stalks, fades Mrsaintpatrick in stretch when deceleration vulnerability exposes.

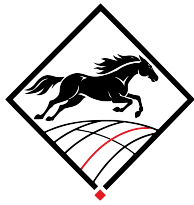
